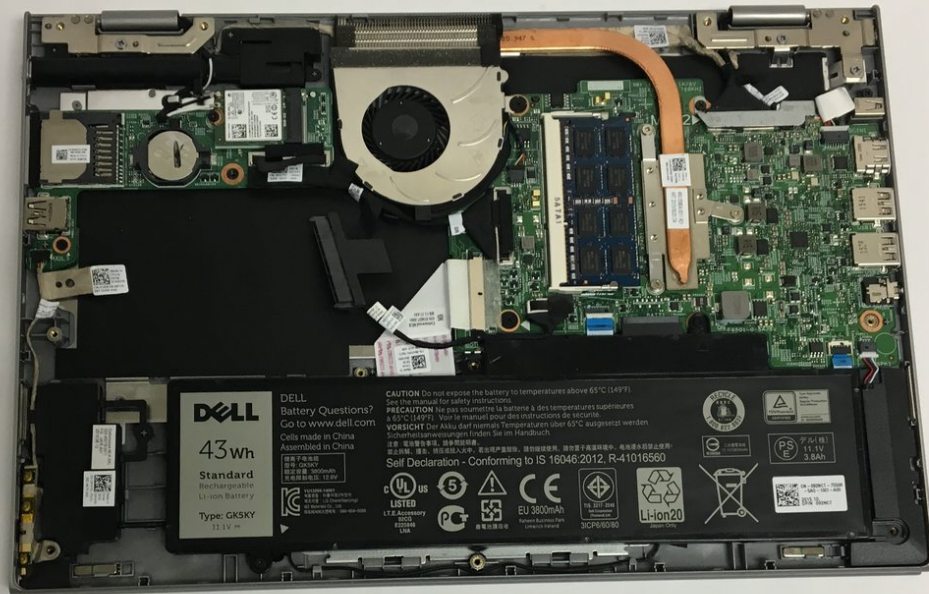




Dell Inspiron 13-7359 Hard Drive Replacement

Learn how to remove your old Hard Drive and replace it with a new one.

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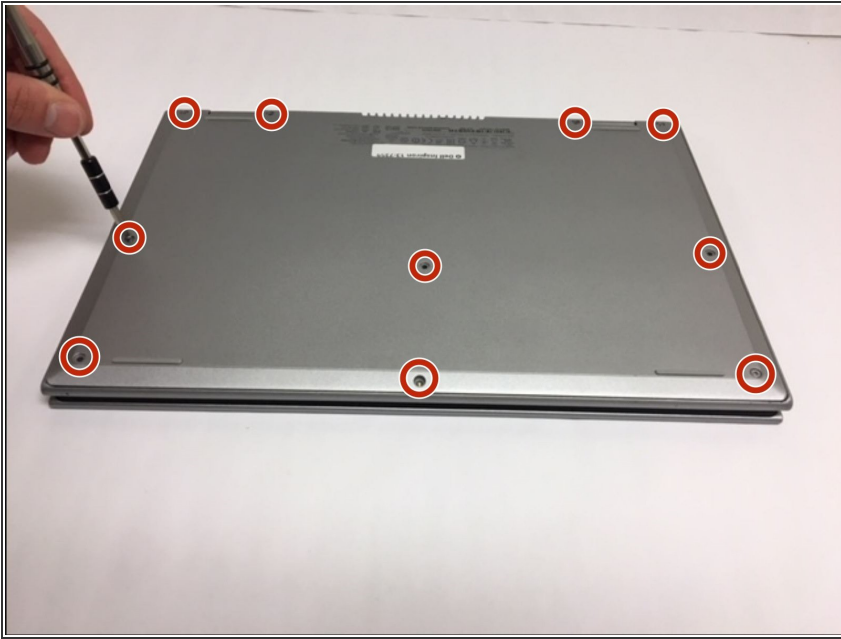
INTRODUCTION

This guide will provide information needed to replace your Dell Inspiron 13-7359 hard drive. You will need a phillips #0 screwdriver and a small plastic spudger.

TOOLS:

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Step 1 — Back Cover



- Flip your device over so the back cover is facing you.
- Using a Phillips #0 Screwdriver, remove the ten 7mm screws holding the back cover in place.

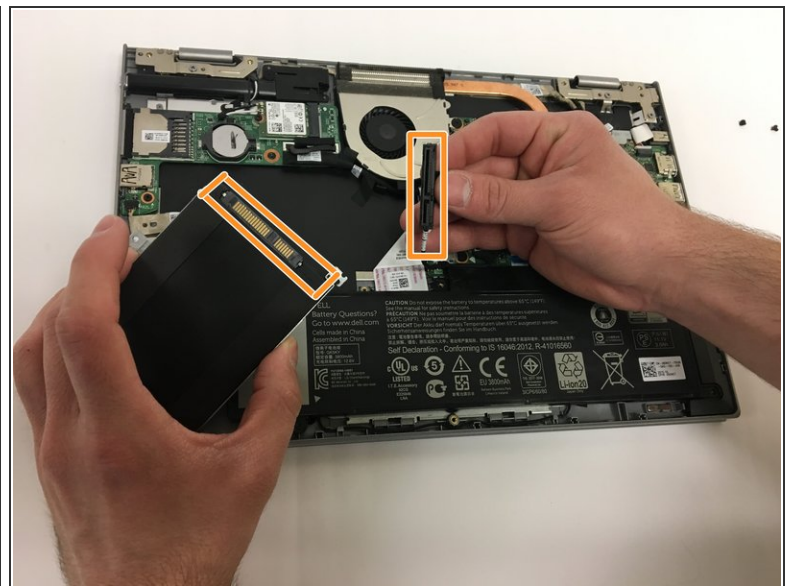
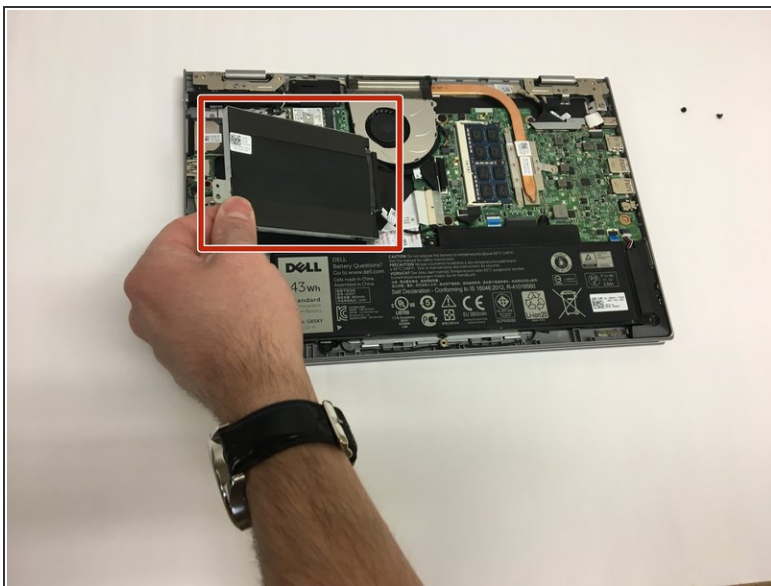
- Insert a plastic opening and run it along the edge of the back cover. Do this until the entire back cover can be removed.

Step 3 — Hard Drive



- Unscrew and remove the 2 of the 3mm Phillips head screws holding the hard drive in place.

Step 4



- Lift and hold the hard drive in your left hand.
- Use your right hand to grab hold of the black wire connector attached on the right of the hard drive.
- Carefully pull the connector away from the hard drive to completely disconnect from the laptop.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
