INTRODUCTION

This guide will inform readers on how to replace the optical drive which may have stopped reading disks.

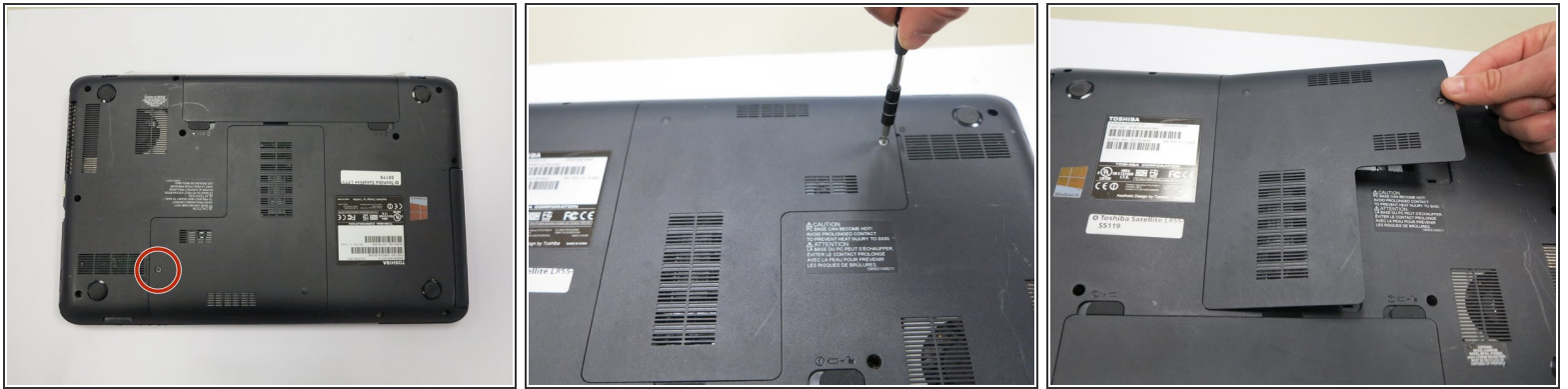
TOOLS:

- [Phillips #0 Screwdriver](#) (1)
- [Phillips #1 Screwdriver](#) (1)

Step 1 — Back Plate Removal



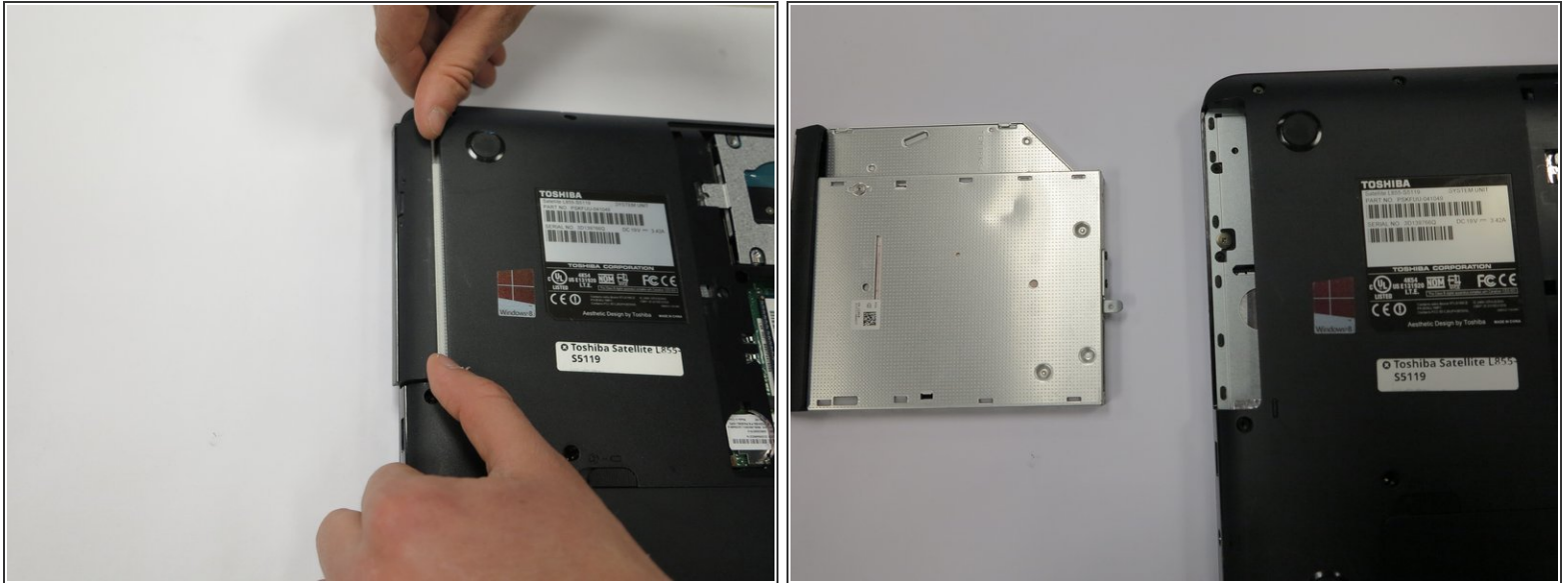
- Turn the laptop over to place it top down.
- Use a Phillips #1 screwdriver to remove the screw holding in the back plate. This screw does not come out of the plate.
- Lift the back plate off the laptop, exposing the RAM and Hard Disk.

Step 2 — Optical Drive



- Using a Phillips #0 screwdriver, remove the single 3mm screw.

Step 3



- Rotate the laptop so that you have access to the optical drive.
- ⓘ The optical drive is now only attached by a port in the drive's back. The optical drive can be pulled straight out of its housing.
- Remove the drive.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
