INTRODUCTION

By following this guide you will be able to remove and replace the quad side button array on your Logitech G700s gaming mouse.

Step 1 — Top Case Replacement



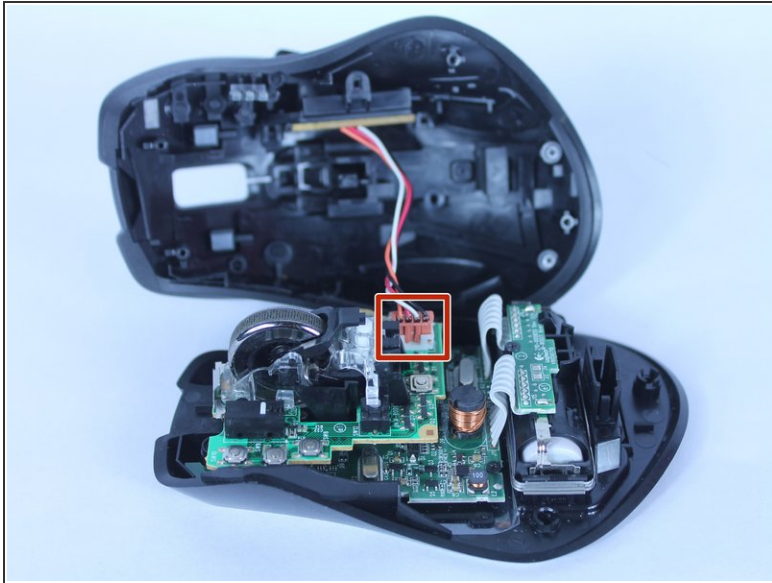
- Remove the batteries from the mouse.
- Use a plastic opening tool to peel up the four mouse feet.

Step 2



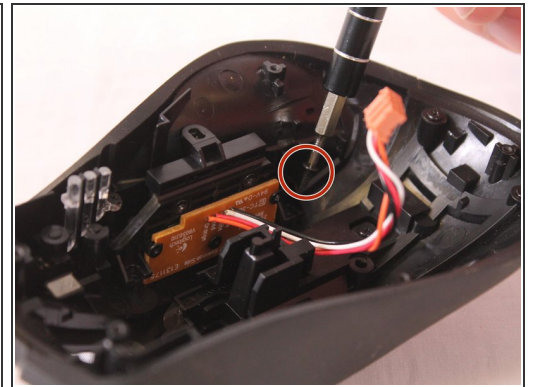
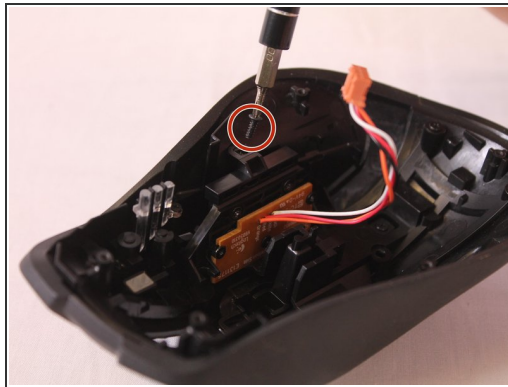
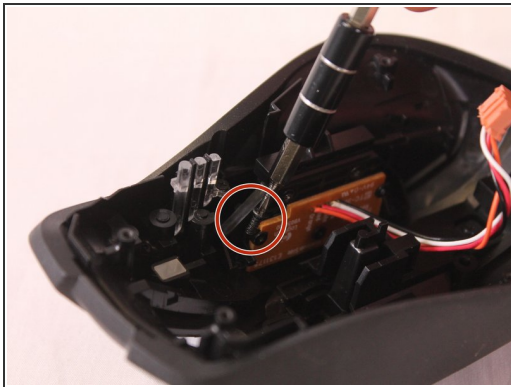
- Remove the five 5.5mm Phillips #00 screws found underneath the mouse feet.

Step 3



- Pull the top of the mouse off of the bottom half.
 - ⓘ There's a wire connecting the two halves.
- Unplug the programmable buttons from the motherboard.

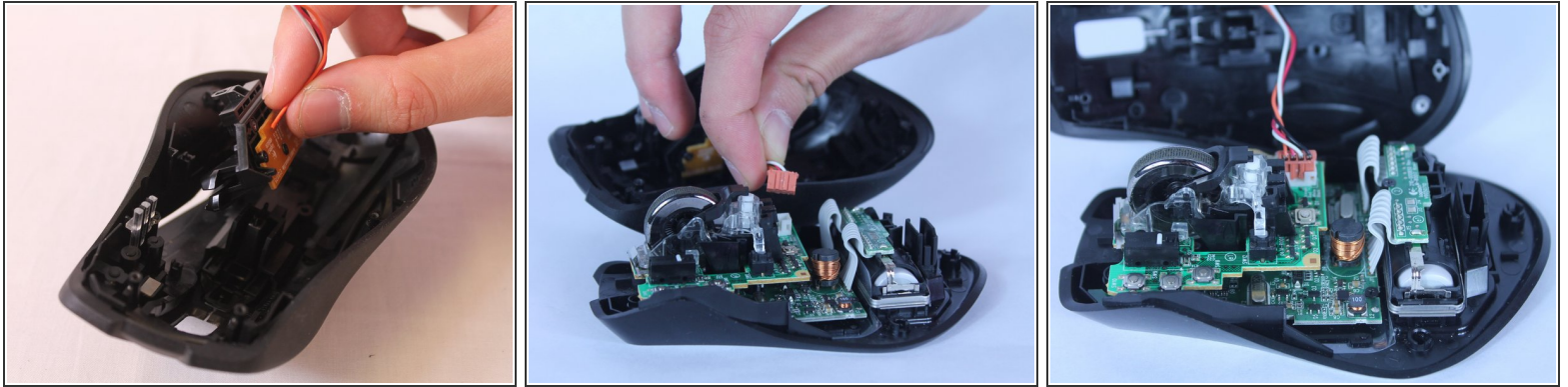
Step 4 — Programmable Side Buttons



- Remove the three 5.5mm Phillips #00 screws holding the button assembly to the mouse.

⚠ Do not remove any of the screws on the circuit board, only the ones holding the plastic assembly in place

Step 5



- Disconnect the button board from the motherboard and remove the whole assembly.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
