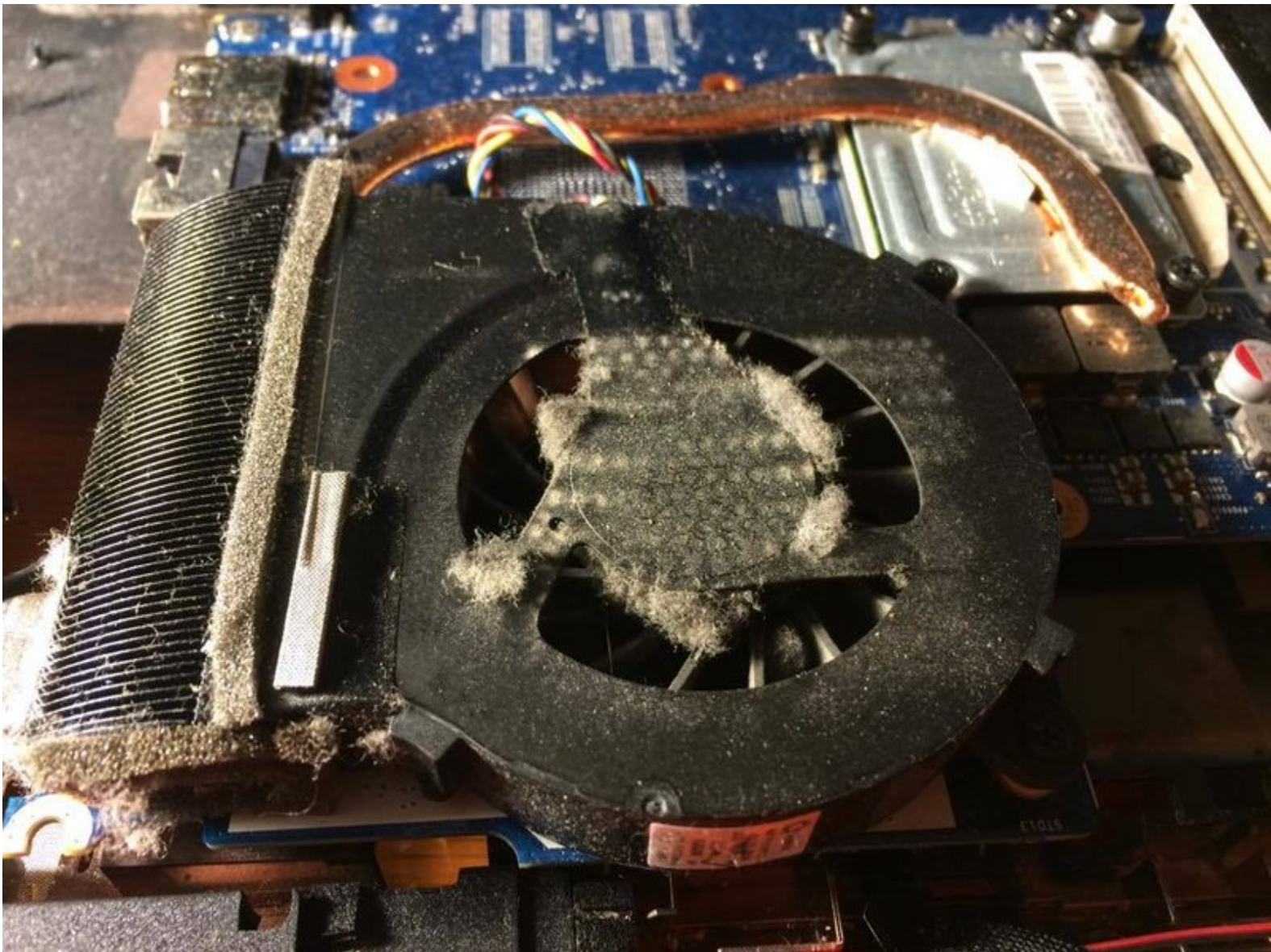




How to Dust a MSI GS70

INTRODUCTION

Every laptop needs a good dusting from time to time. Neglecting this could lead to dust infiltrating vital components or overheating and a forced shutdown.

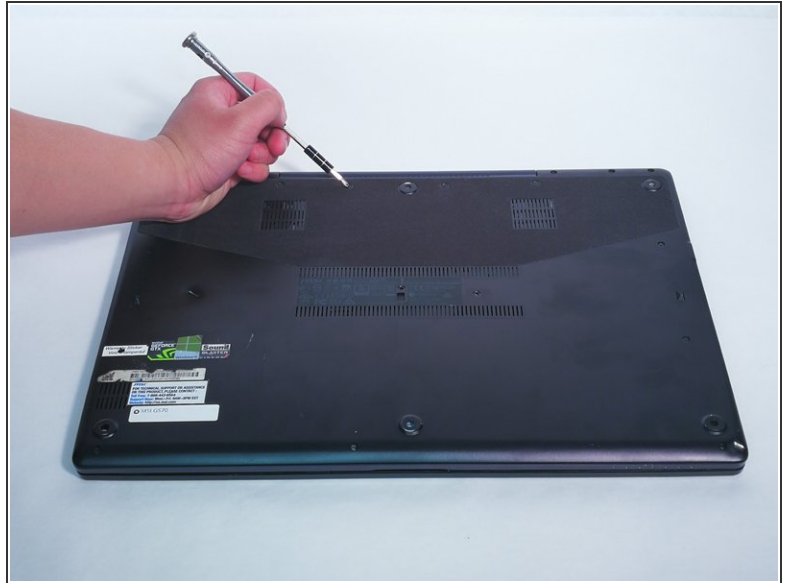

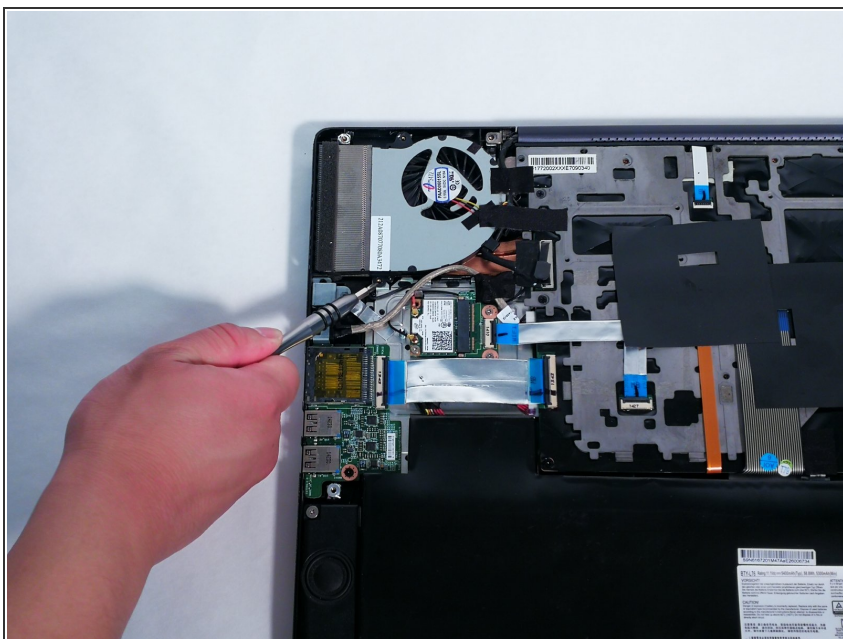

Step 1 — How to Dust a MSI GS70



- Locate and remove the screws holding the back plate.
- Place the screws on the magnetic mat.
- Locate one of the openings on the side and gently pull up to remove the back plate.

Step 2



- Determine how dusty the laptop is starting with the fans. The fans will usually accumulate the most dust.

Step 3



- Have the vacuum and compressed air ready.
- With the compressed air, blow at an angle and from a distance to displace the dust.
- Quickly use the vacuum to catch the dust.

After finishing, the components of your laptop should look almost brand new. Push and screw in the back plate once you finish.
