



Samsung Epic 4G Battery Replacement

This guide demonstrates how you remove and replace your battery in your Samsung Epic 4g.

INTRODUCTION

After operating the phone for an extended period of time, the battery will deplete. With regular use, a battery will lose its charge within 24 hours of the phone's separation from the charger. If your battery starts to deplete quicker than it used to, you should replace the component. This guide tells you how to replace your current battery with a new one. Replacement batteries are easily found online via a Internet search.

Step 1 — Phone Case



- Turn off the phone using the "Power Button" located on the left side of the phone.
- Slide your fingernail along the edge of the device and pull at the plastic backing as shown in the figure.
- ⓘ While pulling at the backing, you will hear a snap. This means it is coming off the phone.

Step 2



- After hearing the snap, pull at the plastic backing gently to remove it.

Step 3 — Battery



- Remove the battery from the device by pulling up on the battery edge.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
