INTRODUCTION

Use this guide to remove the rear lens cover of your LG V20.



TOOLS:

- iFixit Opening Picks set of 6 (1)
- iOpener (1)



PARTS:

LG V20 Rear Lens Cover (1)

Step 1 — Back Cover







- Press the button on the lower right side of the LG V20 to open the clamp that holds the back cover on the back side of the phone.
- Remove the back cover.

Step 2 — Battery







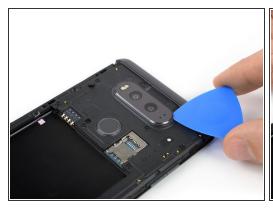
- A Before disassembling your phone, discharge the battery below 25%. A charged lithium-ion battery can catch fire and/or explode if accidentally punctured.
- Use the flat end of a spudger and insert it in the small recess at the lower end of the battery.
- Use the spudger to lever out the battery and remove it.
 - (i) You can do this with your fingers but take care not to puncture the battery with your fingernails.

Step 3 — Rear Lens Cover



 Use an iOpener to loosen the adhesive beneath the rear lens cover.

Step 4







- Use the tip of an opening pick to gently pry up the rear lens cover.
- Use the tip of the opening pick and slide around the whole rear lens cover to cut the adhesive beneath.

Step 5



Remove the rear lens cover.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order. Apply new adhesive where it's necessary.
