



Lenovo Legion Y520-15IKBN Battery Replacement

This guide will explain in detail how to replace the battery in your Lenovo Legion Y520-15IKBN.

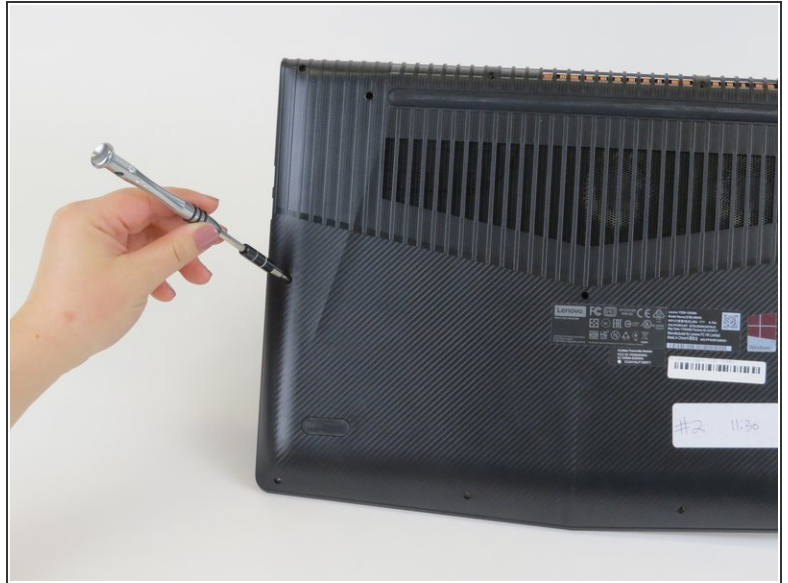
INTRODUCTION

If your laptop will not start up or stay charged you may need to replace the battery. To follow this guide you only need a plastic opening tool such as a spudger or credit card and a Phillips #00 screwdriver. It is not a difficult project and the hardest part will be prying the back piece off.

Step 1 — Battery



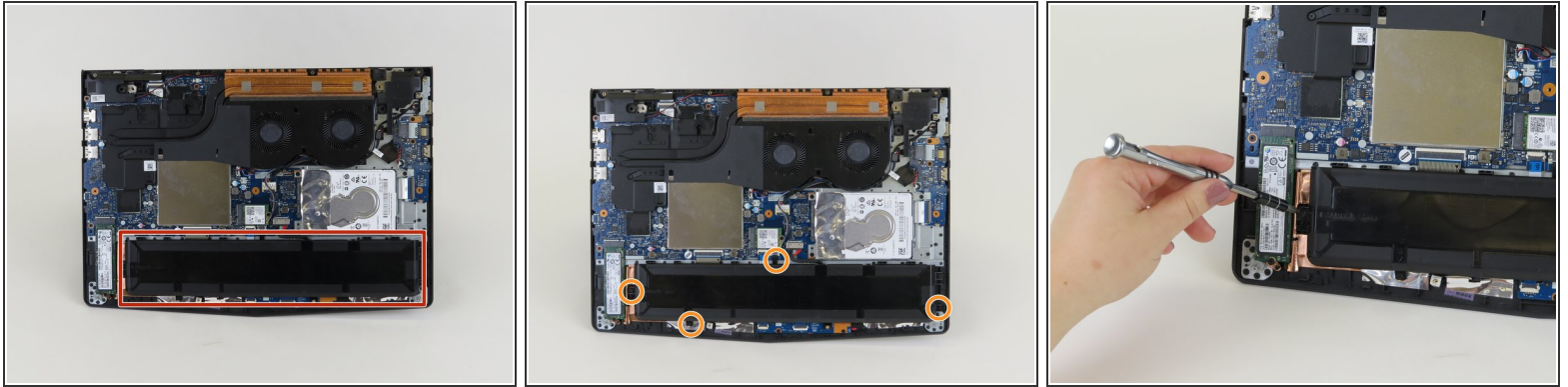
- Remove thirteen 6.5 mm screws from the bottom of the laptop using a Phillips #00 screwdriver.

Step 2



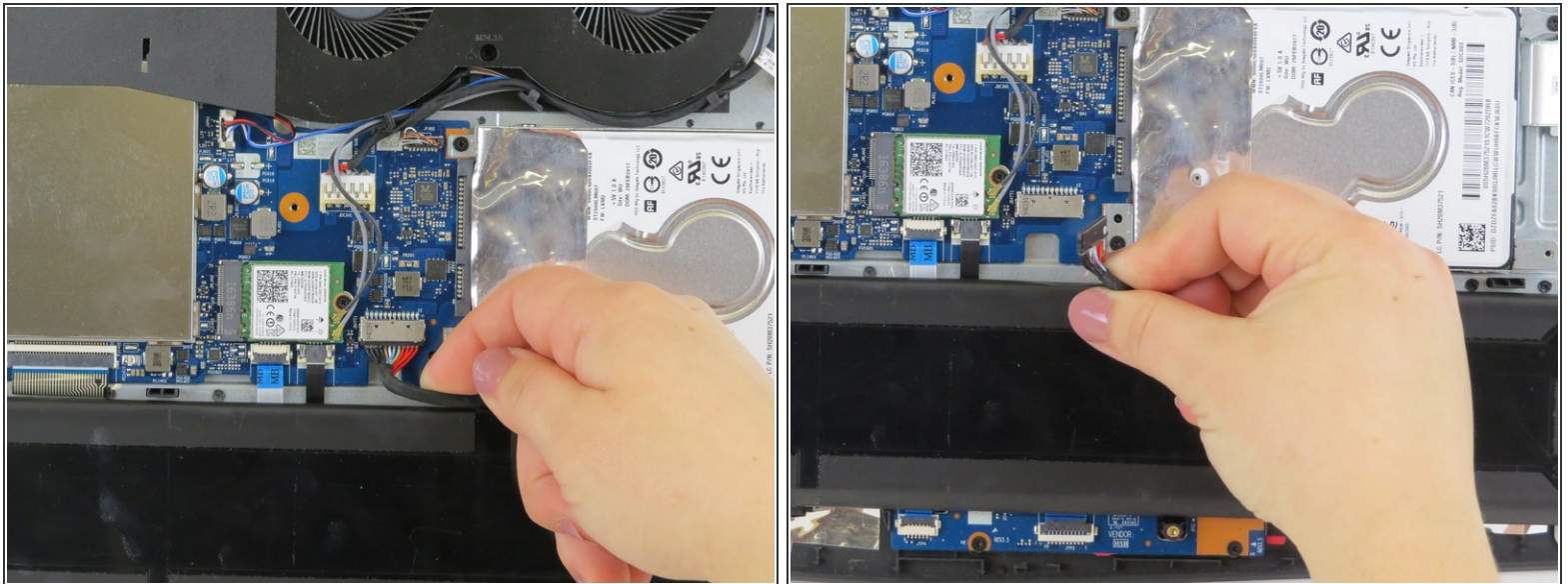
- Flip the laptop on its side and use a spudger or a credit card to pry the bottom covering off. To get a better grip you may want to open the laptop slightly.
- The bottom piece will make popping noises as it is pulled from the laptop.
- When reassembling make sure that the bottom piece clicks back into place on all sides of the laptop.

Step 3



- The battery is a long black rectangle located near the bottom of the device.
- Use a Phillips #00 screwdriver to unscrew the four 4.0 mm screws holding the battery in place.

Step 4



- There is a small bundle of wires held together with black tape located on the top edge of the battery. Unplug it completely.
- ✦ When reassembling remember to plug these wires back into the port.
- ⓘ When removing the bundle it may feel fragile but don't be afraid to give it a tug.

Step 5



- Lift the battery out of the laptop body.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
