INTRODUCTION

Clogged filter?

This guide will show you how to remove the water filter found inside the Keurig B70 Platinum water reservoir.

You will only need a Phillips #2 screwdriver for this guide.



TOOLS:

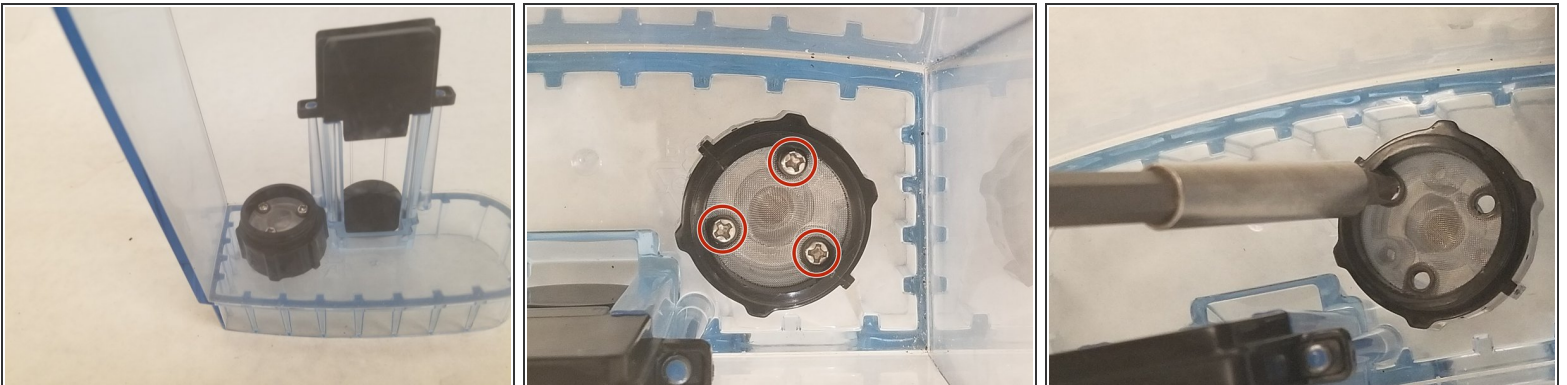
- [Phillips #2 Screwdriver](#) (1)

Step 1 — Water Filter



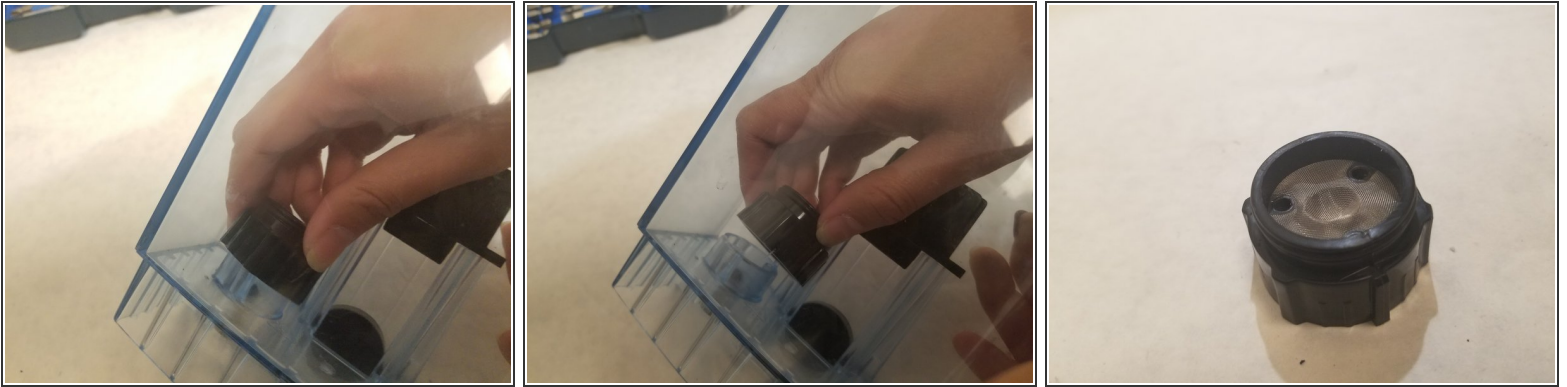
- Remove the water reservoir from the Keurig by lifting it upwards and pulling it outwards.
- ⓘ Be sure to empty the reservoir before continuing to the next step.

Step 2



- Remove the three 11.0 mm screws from the reservoir filter.
- ⓘ You may need to use tweezers to pull out the screws.

Step 3



- Firmly twist the filter counterclockwise to remove it.
- ⓘ When adding the replacement filter, make sure the filter lines up with the screw holes.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
