



Softball Glove Heel Replacement

Step by step instructions with pictures on how to restring the heel of a softball glove.

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INTRODUCTION

Before beginning this guide, be sure to have a Glove Lacing Tool or something very similar. This will make the repair go faster and with more ease. Restringing a glove will make the glove tighter and more secure on the hand of the player.



TOOLS:

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Step 1 — Softball Glove Heel Replacement



- Gather your materials; the glove, scissors, new thread, and the Glove Lacing Tool
- Identify the pieces of lace that are broken and causing the problem

Step 2



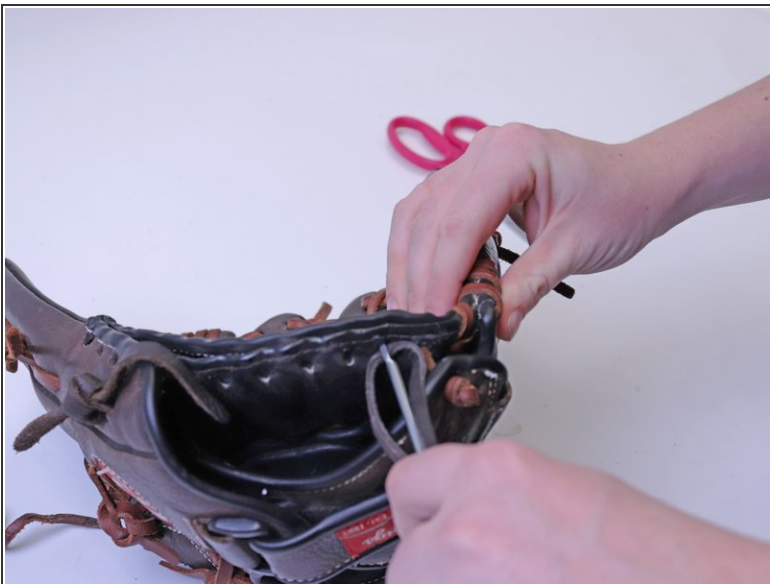
- Take out any remaining lace that is broken or lace that is surrounding that area

Step 3



- Thread the new lace through the Rawlings lacing tool like a needle and thread

Step 4



- Using the Rawlings Glove Lacing Tool, start to weave the thread through the spot in the glove that needs repaired

Step 5



- Continue to weave

Step 6



- Tie the knot with the end of the thread. The knot needs to be tight in order to keep the weaving in place

Step 7



- Cut off excess thread using the scissors

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.

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
