



How to Reattach a Broken Drawer Cart Wheel

This is a guide for fixing the broken underside of a drawer cart and replacing the wheels.

INTRODUCTION

Hello! This simple guide will show you how to replace the wheels underneath the drawer cart. These type of drawer carts are not well arranged, they are cheap and are likely to break more quickly, so if the wheels beneath your drawer cart are missing or are broken, this guide is perfect for you.

Step 1 — Wheels



- Use a heat gun or other heat source to fuse the broken hole.
- ⓘ A soldering iron worked fine for my fix, but was difficult to clean!

Step 2



- Wait for the welded hole to cool down.

Step 3



- Assemble the wheel.

Step 4



- Coat the metal part of the wheel with super glue.

Step 5



- Insert the glue coated metal tab of the wheel inside the hole.

Step 6



- Repeat for all corners.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
