Step 1 — The Mouse



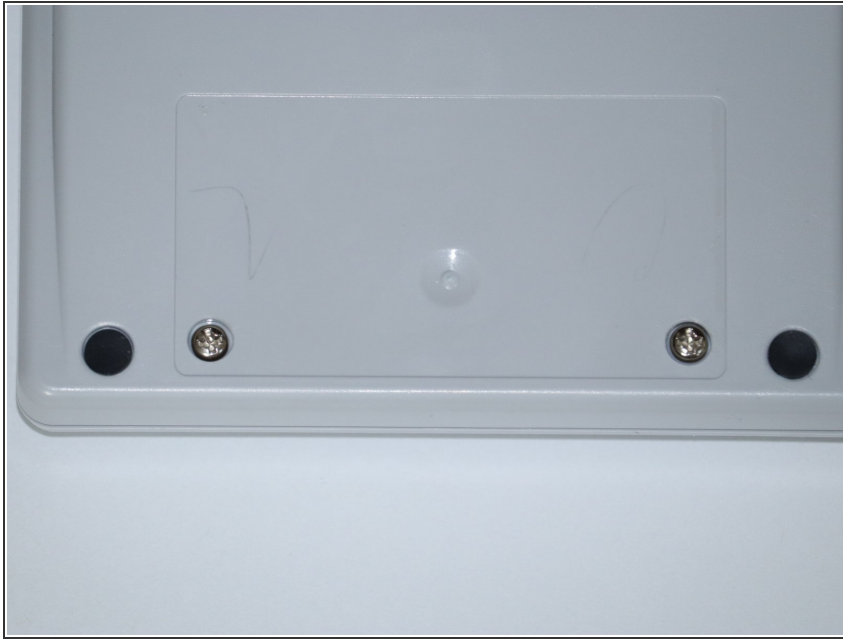
- This is the Kensington Expert Trackball Mouse. This ergonomic mouse, from the 1990s, features a roller ball, and 4 tactile buttons. Begin by removing the roller ball by flipping the mouse upside down.

Step 2 — Remove the Sticker



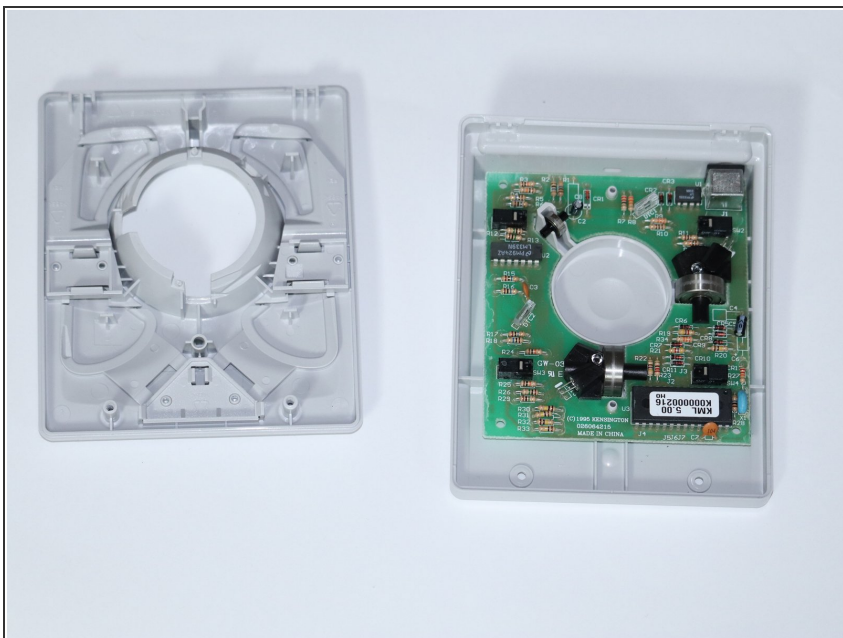
- Begin by peeling the sticker from the back of the mouse.

Step 3 — Unscrew the Back Plate



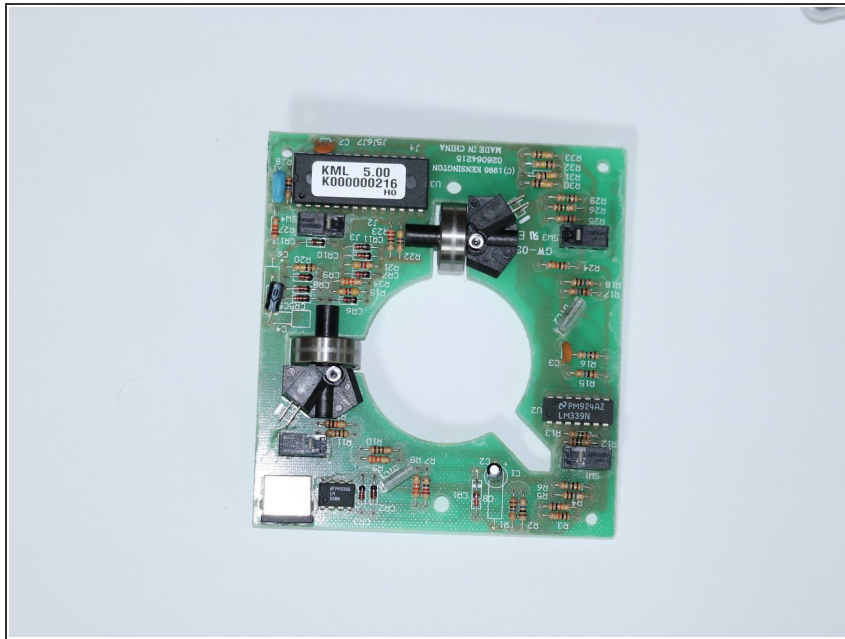
- Remove the phillips screws.

Step 4 — Pull it Apart!



- Separate the top and bottom halves of the mouse.

Step 5 — A Closer Look at the Circuit Board



- The simple circuit board features many modular components, making repairs easy.

Step 6 — Congratulations!



- You took your Kensington Expert Trackball Mouse apart!
