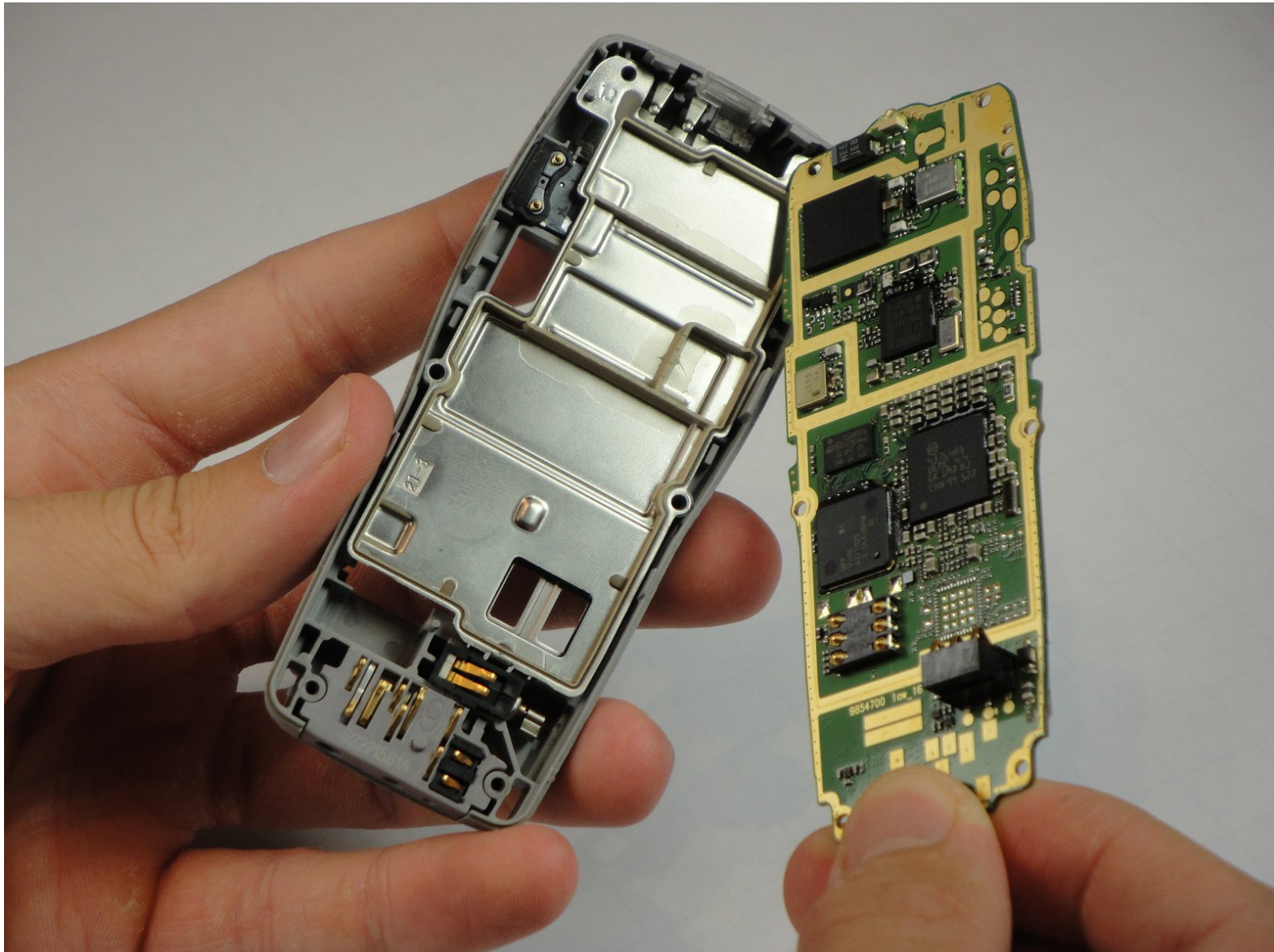




Nokia 1100b RH-36 Motherboard and Keyboard Replacement

Replace a defective keyboard or motherboard in your Nokia 1100b RH-36.

INTRODUCTION

This guide will show you how to install a new motherboard and keyboard unit in your phone.

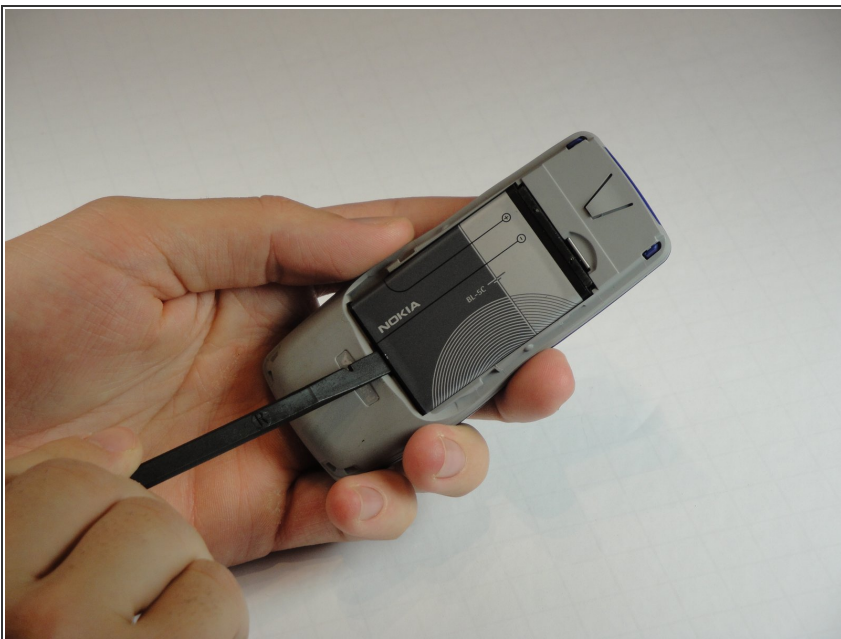

Step 1 — Battery Cover



- Flip the phone over so that the screen faces down.
- Press the gray button on the battery cover and slide it down off the back of the phone.

Step 2 — Battery



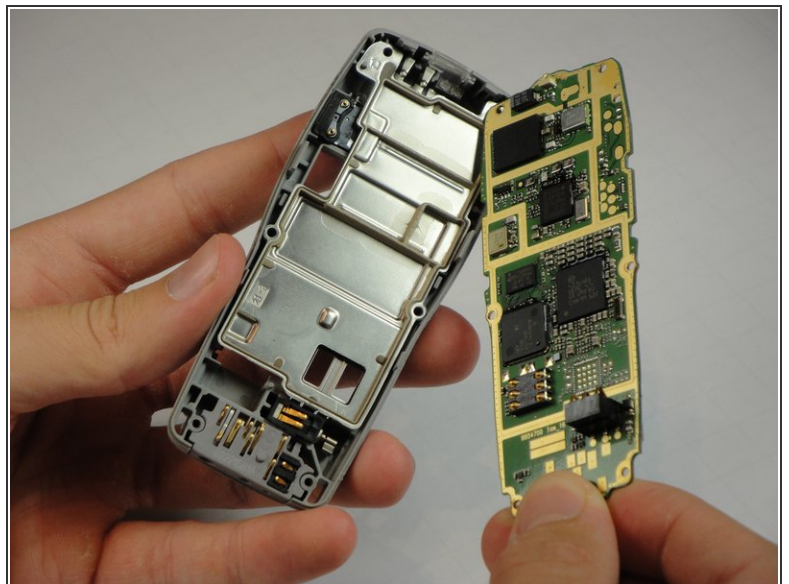
- Wedge the flat end of the spudger into the small indent next to the Nokia logo on the battery.
- Gently pry the battery out of the phone.

Step 3 — Inner Casing



- Remove the six 6mm T6 Torx screws around the edge of the front of the phone.
- Remove the metal frame holding the screen and speaker.

Step 4 — Motherboard and Keyboard



- Gently lift motherboard unit out of the case.
- The motherboard and keyboard are one unit and are replaced together.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
