



Google Pixel 7 Camera Glass Replacement

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INTRODUCTION

This guide covers the replacement of the rear camera glass on the Google Pixel 7. This may be useful for you if your cameras/sensors are still intact, but the glass protecting them is shattered and/or damaged. Replacement glass cut to fit the Pixel 7 can be found for purchase online.

Step 1 — Camera Glass



- Heat the camera glass with a hair dryer to soften the adhesive.

Step 2 — Remove the Damaged Glass



- Using a knife, carefully remove the broken glass covering the camera sensors.
- After removing all glass, carefully clean the camera lenses with a microfiber cloth. **Be cautious of any glass fragments that may remain.**

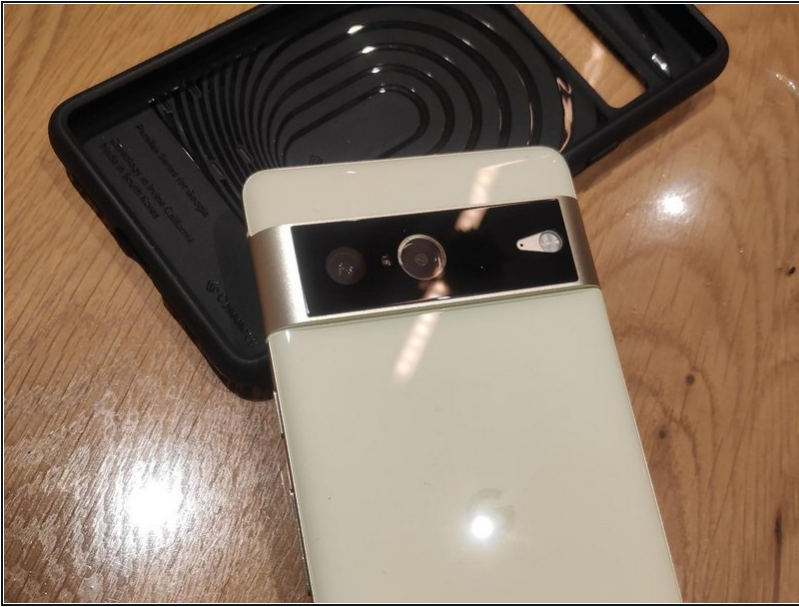
Step 3 — Insert the Replacement Glass



⚠ Beware that replacement of the glass can cause many problems, specifically with the new adhesive clouding up pictures.

- Insert the new glass with the adhesive side up (unfortunately, if the adhesive layer faces the camera, the image will be blurry).

Step 4 — Apply Full-Surface Protective Glass Cover



- Put on a full-surface glass protector. Make sure that no dust collects between the cover and the device/camera glass.

Follow the steps in reverse order to reassemble your device
