INTRODUCTION

This guide will show you how you can waterproof your iPod Shuffle and earphones DIY, you will be able to use them in the pool in the bath or wherever water is.

Step 1 — Waterproof iPod Shuffle 4th Generation DIY Technique



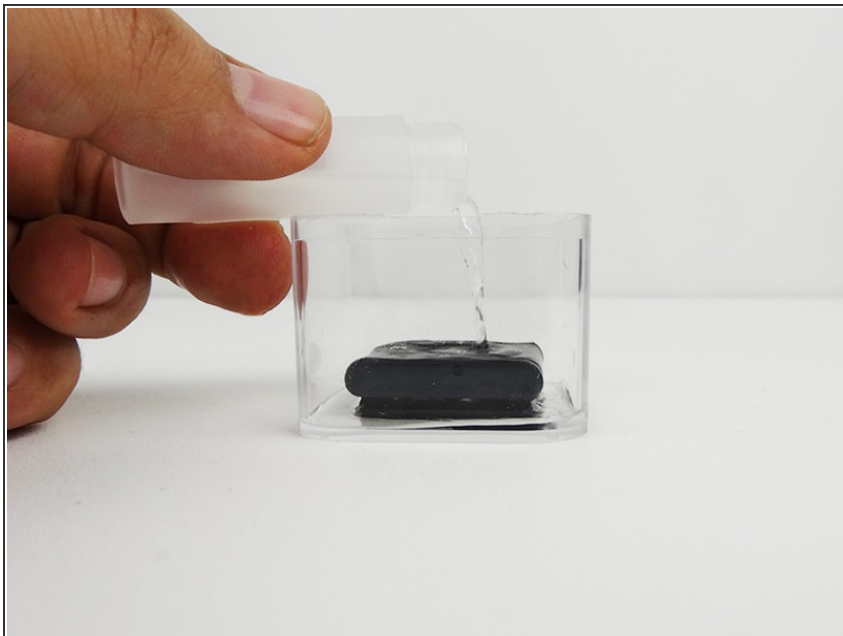
- To start you need the items as pictured. To the right is the waterproof dipping liquid bottle from Nanostate called Flash Flood Green Label, it's 3ml.

Step 2



- You will need to use your ipod shuffle box to complete the waterproofing. If you don't have one you can use any plastic box or even a plastic bag as the coating is non toxic and non hazardous.

Step 3



- Place your ipod shuffle inside the case and pour the liquid coating in.

Step 4



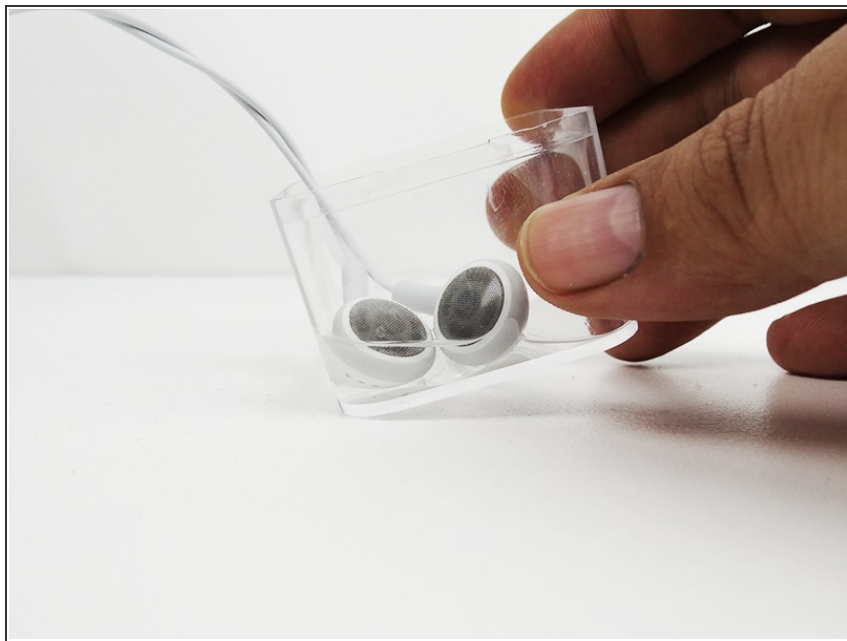
- Place the lid on top and shake gently from left to right for 3 minutes.

Step 5



- Take out the iPod shuffle after the 3 mins and dry with a microfiber cloth. Leave to dry for 3 hours before use.

Step 6



- Again, from right to left cover the earphones & jack with the liquid coating for 3 mins. Take out and dry and do not use for 3 hours.

Step 7



- After the 3 hours drying period, drop your iPod shuffle and earphones in the water for as long as you want ! It's tried and tested and works although you feel your heart stop when you drop it in !

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
