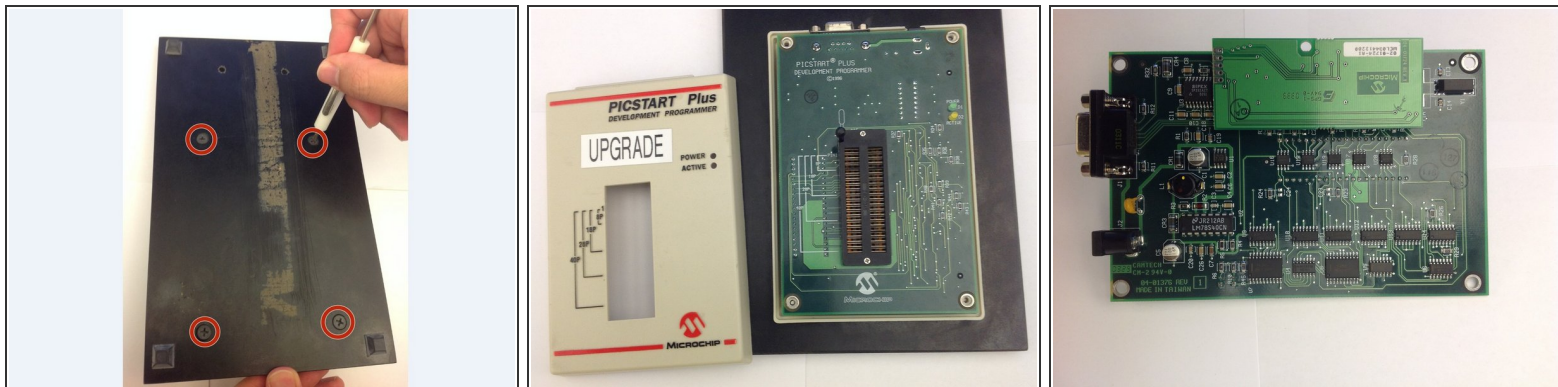

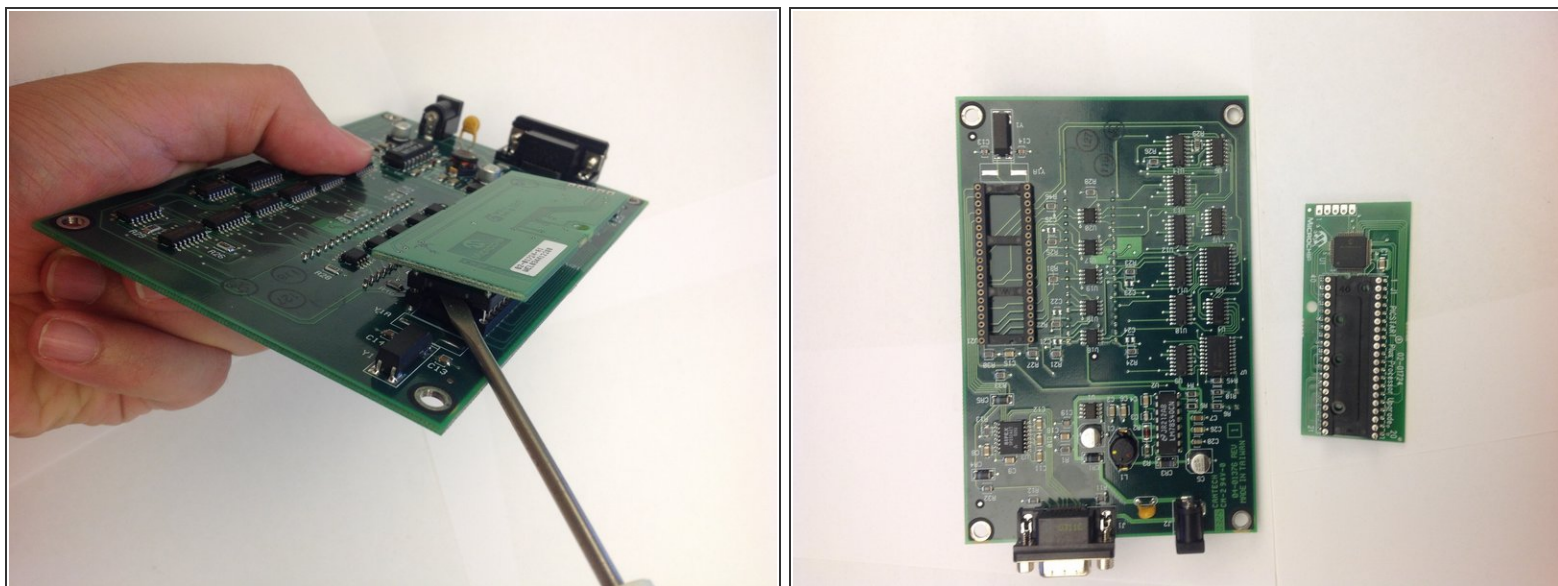

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Step 1 — Picstart Plus Development Programmer Teardown



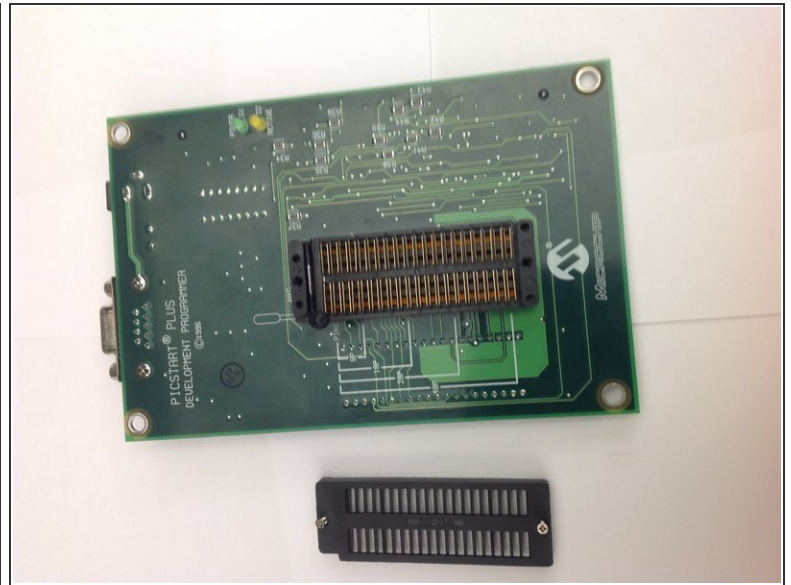
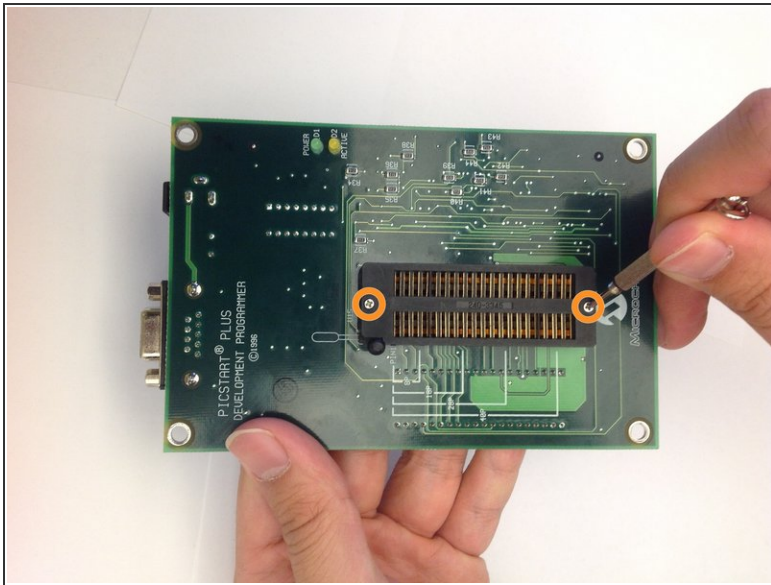
- Remove 4 Phillips screws located on the back side of the holding plate.
- After the screws are removed, remove the case of the development programmer.
- Carefully take out the circuit board with component side facing up. Put the case aside.

Step 2



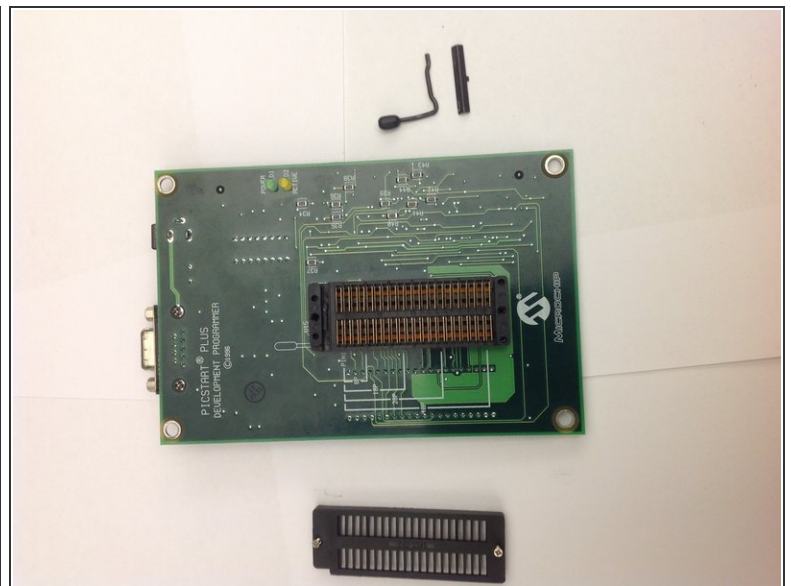
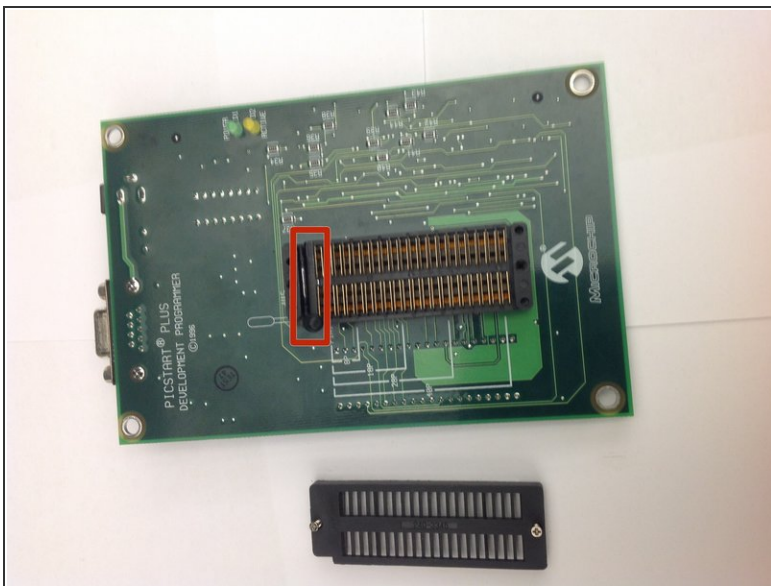
- Disconnect the microcontroller module from the main board using a spudger or a similar tool.
- Set the microcontroller module aside.

Step 3



- Flip over the mainboard so that the component side is facing down and remove the small Pan head screws that holds the cover of the IC holder
- Remove the cover of the IC holder.

Step 4



- Remove the IC holder lever along with the small metal plate that covers the lever.
- Set the lever and the lever cover aside.
