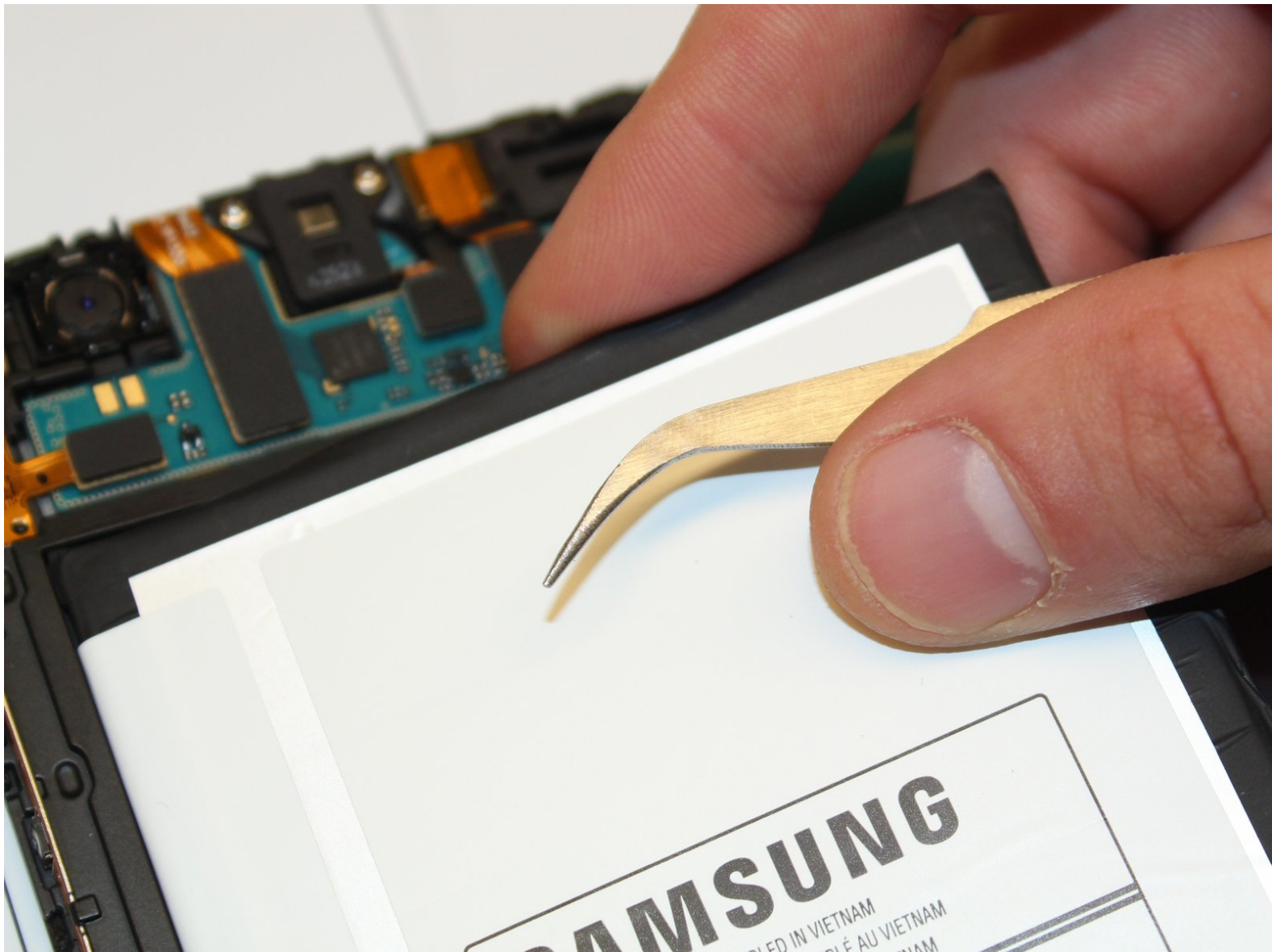




# Samsung Galaxy Tab 3 8.0 Battery Replacement

## INTRODUCTION

Use this guide to replace the battery of your Samsung Galaxy Tab 3 8.0 .

Caution must be exercised with the removal of any parts in order to avoid damage to the device.

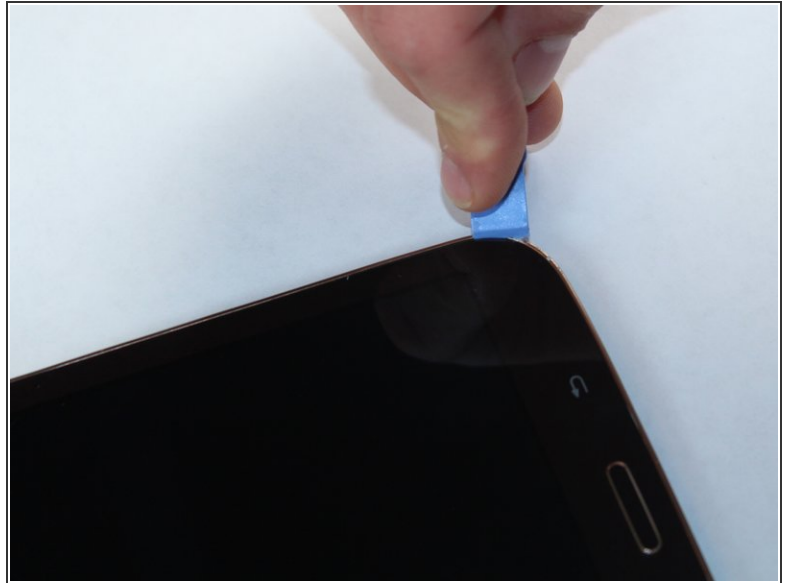
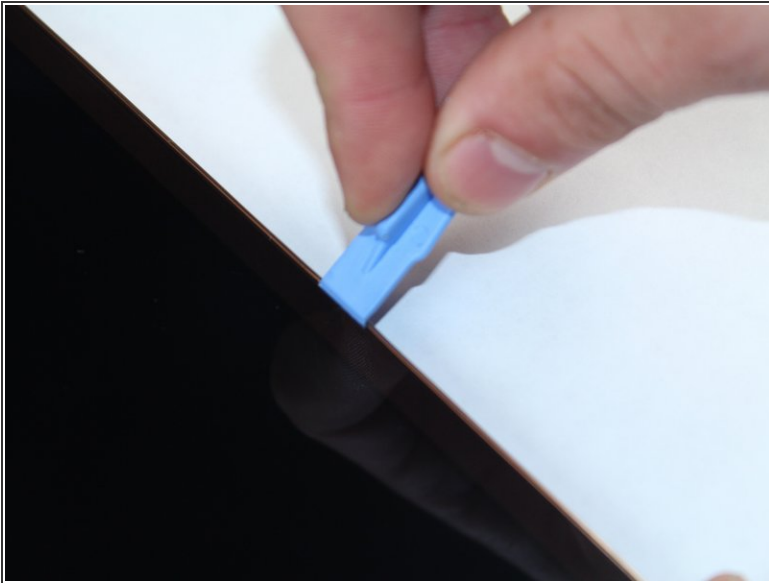

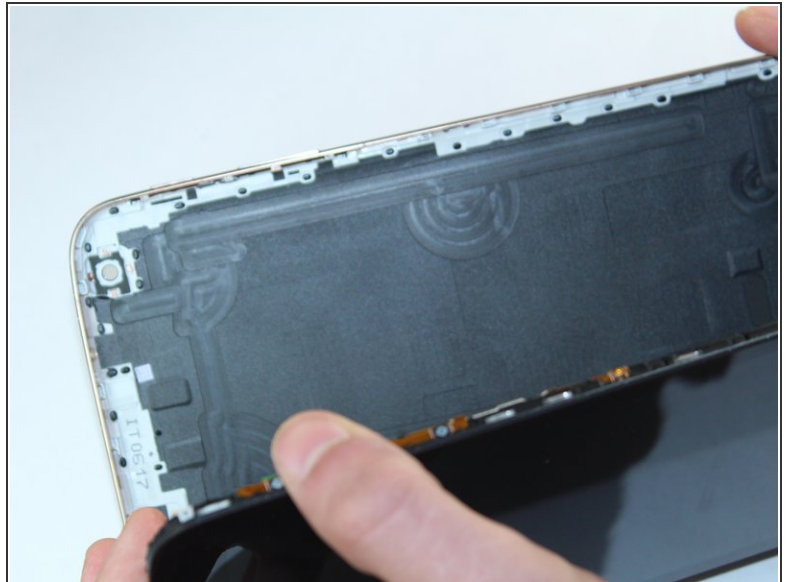
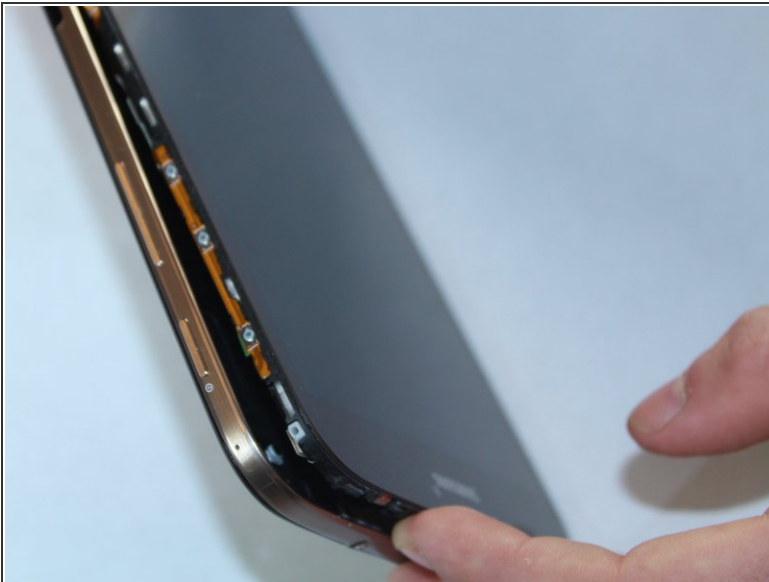
## Step 1 — Battery - Open up the tablet



- Start out by separating the screen from the back cover using the larger plastic opening tool to pry them apart.

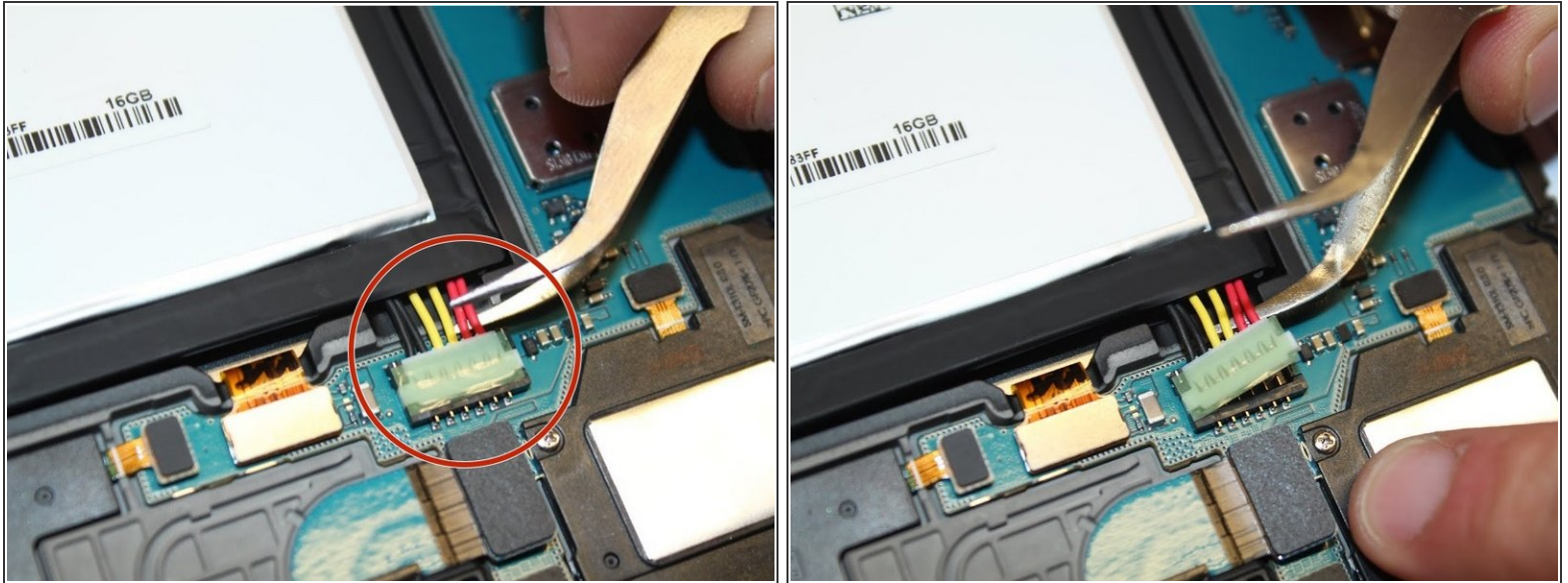
 Be careful when removing the screen as negligence can cause damage.

## Step 2 — Remove Back Cover



- Once every part of the screen is separated from the back cover, you should be able to fully remove it with your hands.

### Step 3 — Disconnect Battery



- To remove the battery you must use something small, such as tweezers, to disconnect the battery from its port.

**i** Note: the connection lifts up to remove.

### Step 4 — Remove Battery



- After the battery is disconnected, use the pulling tab to safely remove the battery.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
