



# Motorola Droid Mini Camera Replacement

This guide will explain how to replace the camera of your Motorola Droid Mini.

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## INTRODUCTION

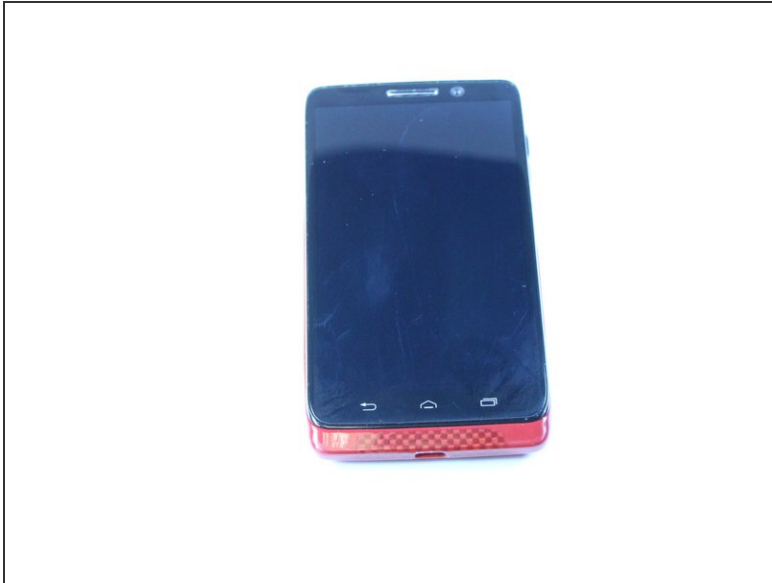
The camera or flash may stop functioning or require eventual replacement. Here is a guide that offers that.

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## Step 1 — Back Case



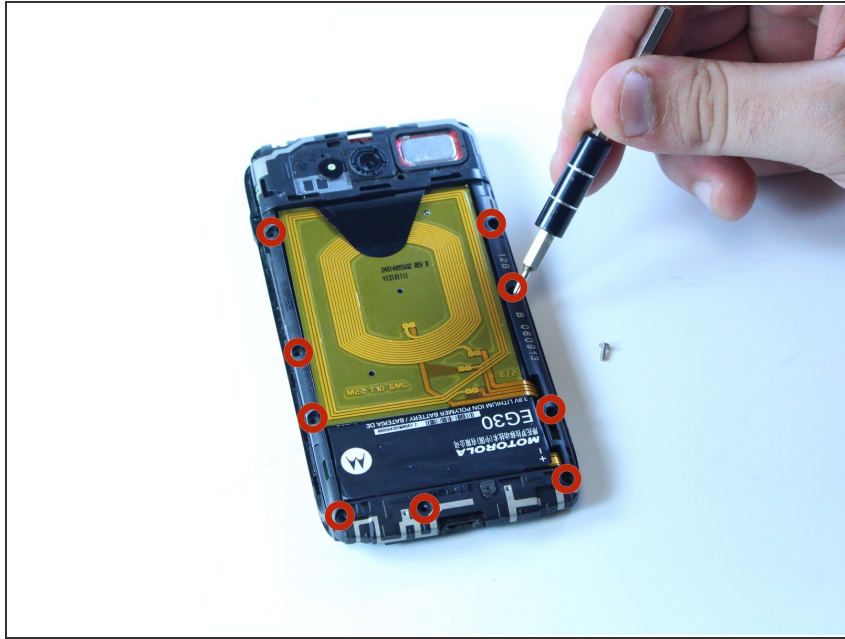
- Pull out the volume keys using the plastic opening tool.

## Step 2



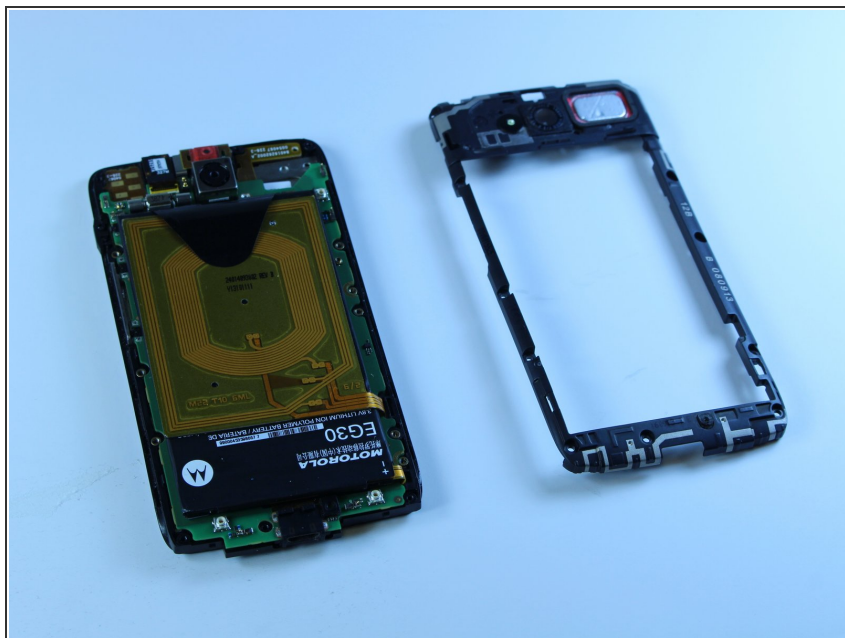
- Use the plastic opening tool to gently pry off the back case. Make sure to go around the entire perimeter of the case.

## Step 3 — Camera



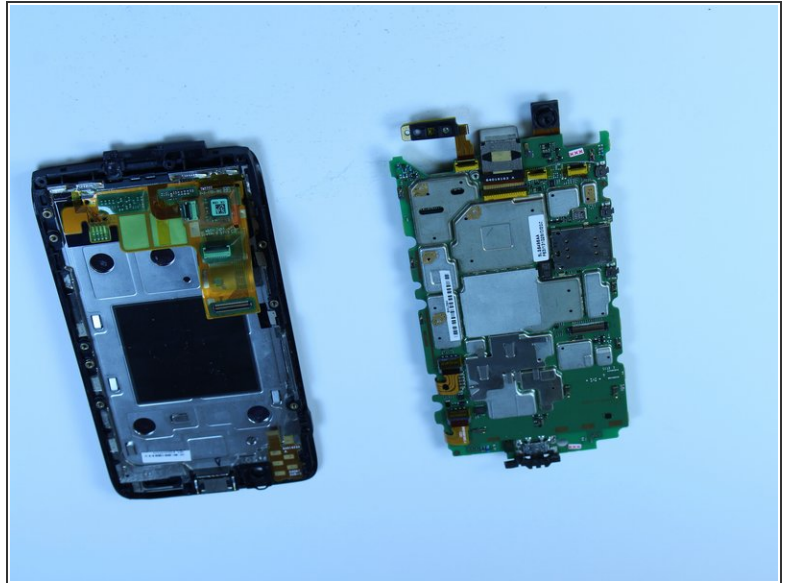
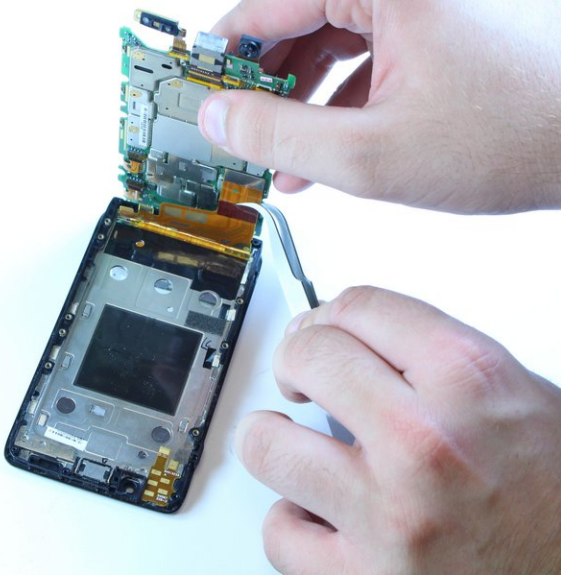
- Use the T5 screw head to unscrew the 9 silver screws from the housing frame.

## Step 4



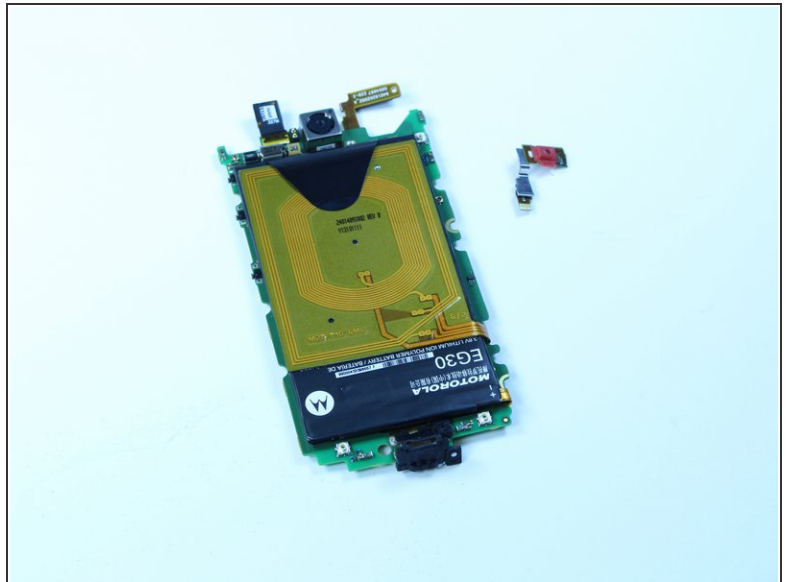
- Carefully separate the housing frame from the motherboard.

## Step 5



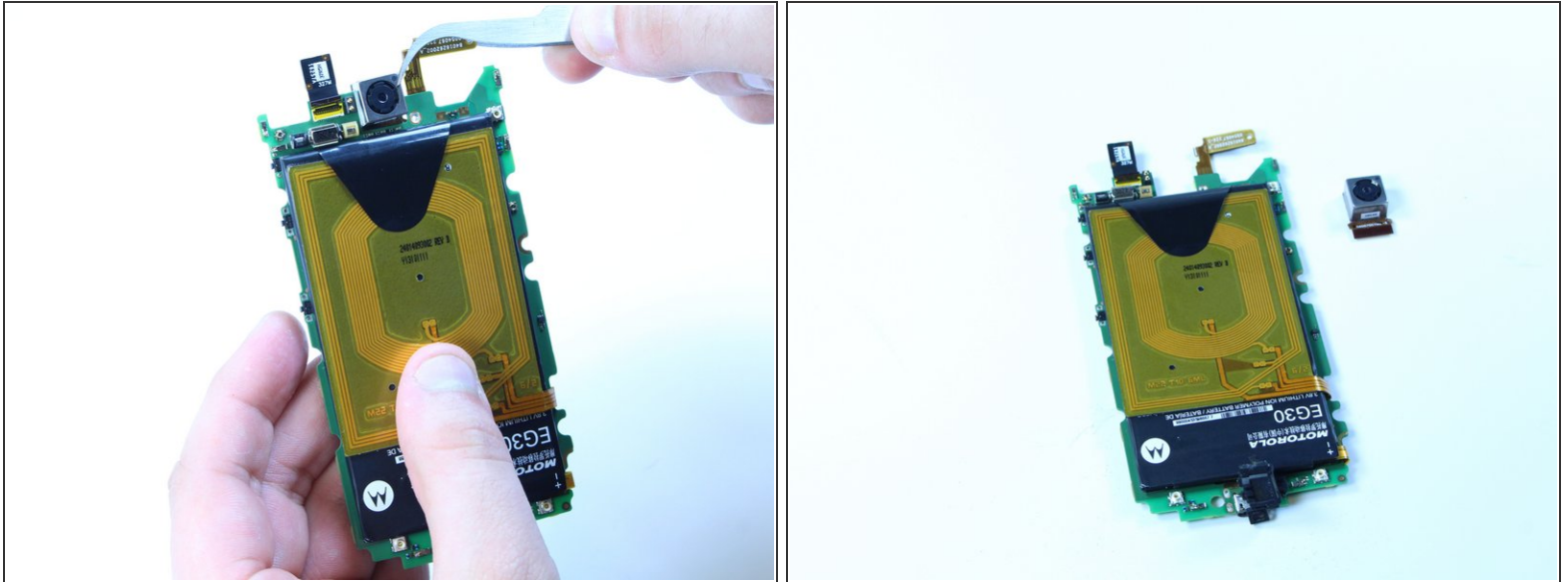
- Carefully use the tweezers to separate the motherboard from the screen.

## Step 6



- Carefully use the tweezers to remove the flash motherboard.

## Step 7



- Using the tweezers, remove the camera from the motherboard.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
