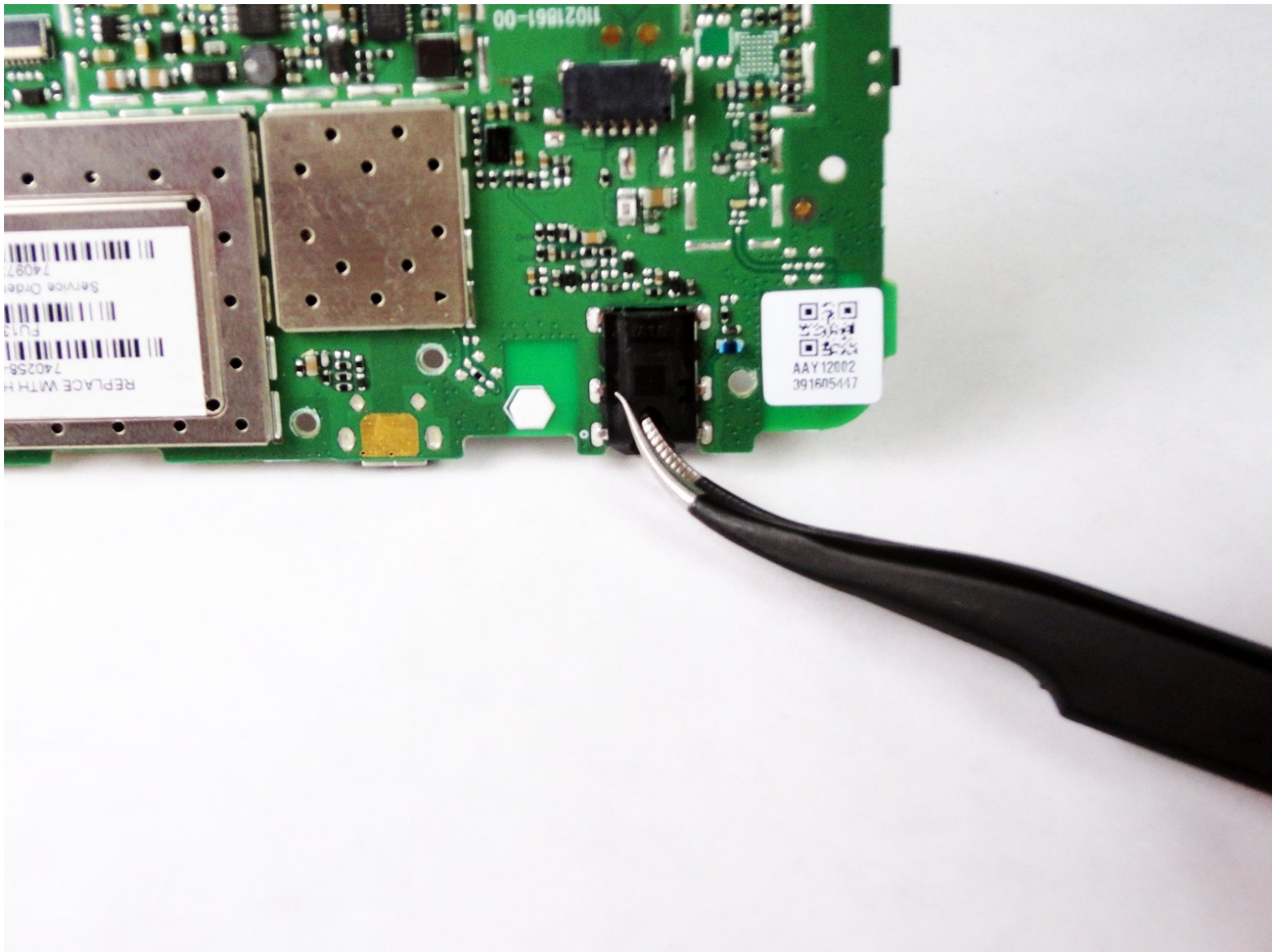




# HP 7 1800 Audio Jack Replacement

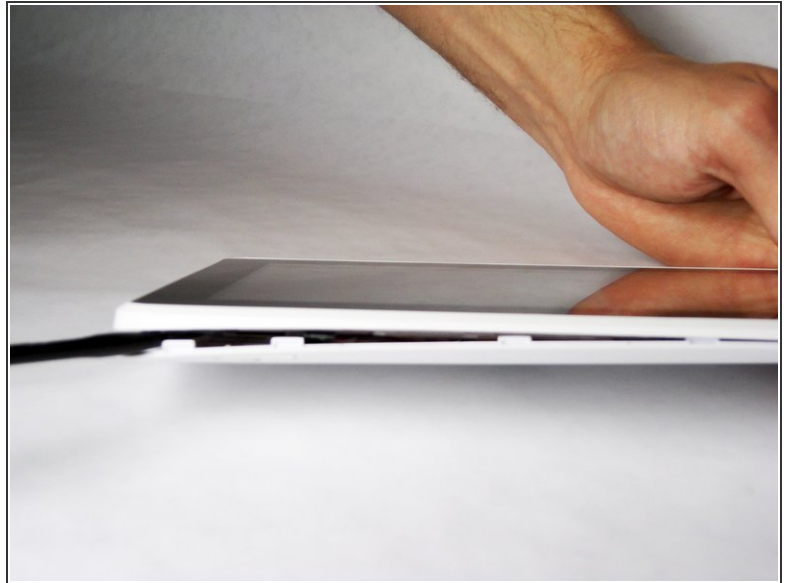
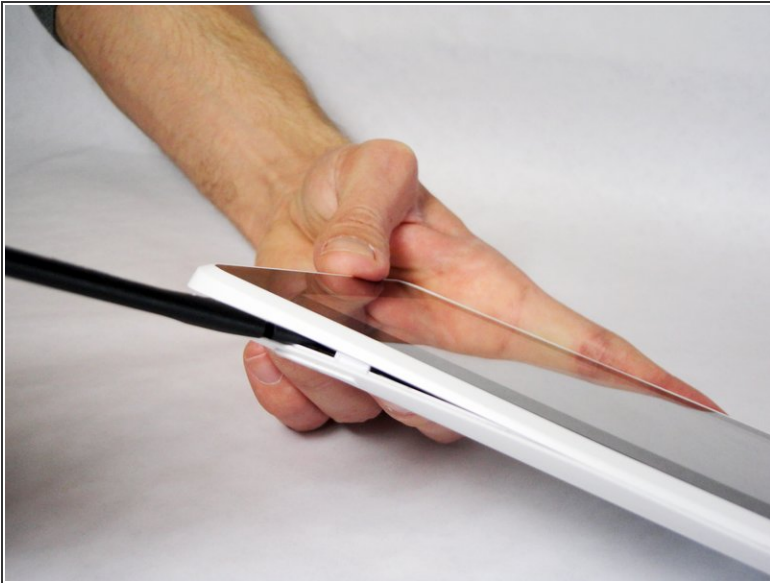
You will be disassembling the HP 7 1800 and using a soldering iron to replace the audio jack.

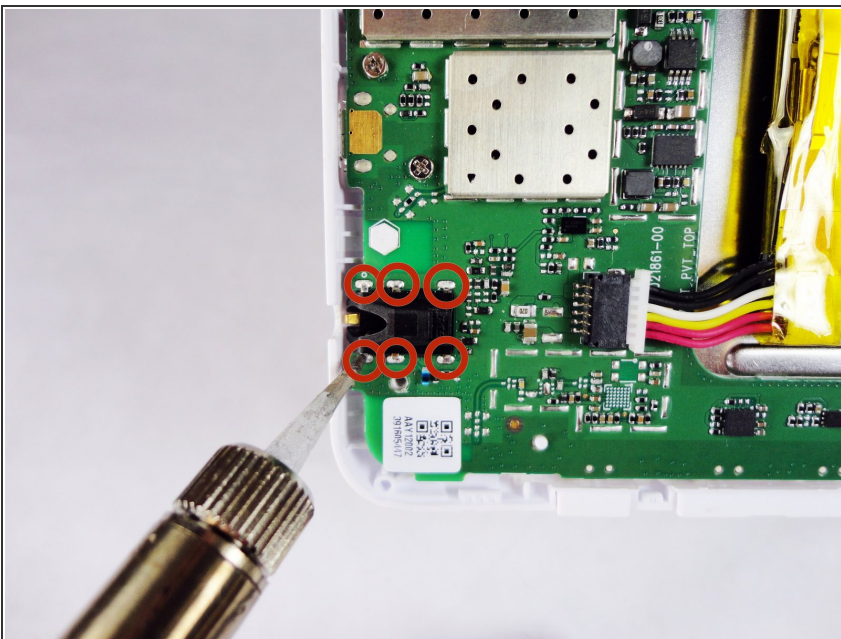

## Step 1 — Remove the back panel



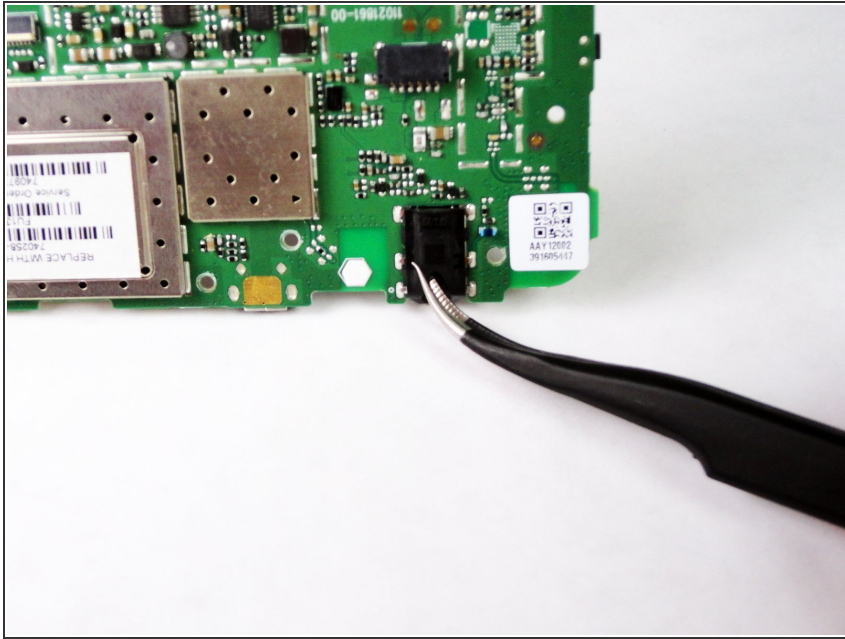
- Use a Spudger to open the back panel. Be careful not to break the tabs.

## Step 2 — Desoldering the audio jack



- Desolder the top lead for the six solder points.

### Step 3 — Removing the audio jack



- Once the solder is removed, gently pull the audio jack away from the motherboard with tweezers.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
