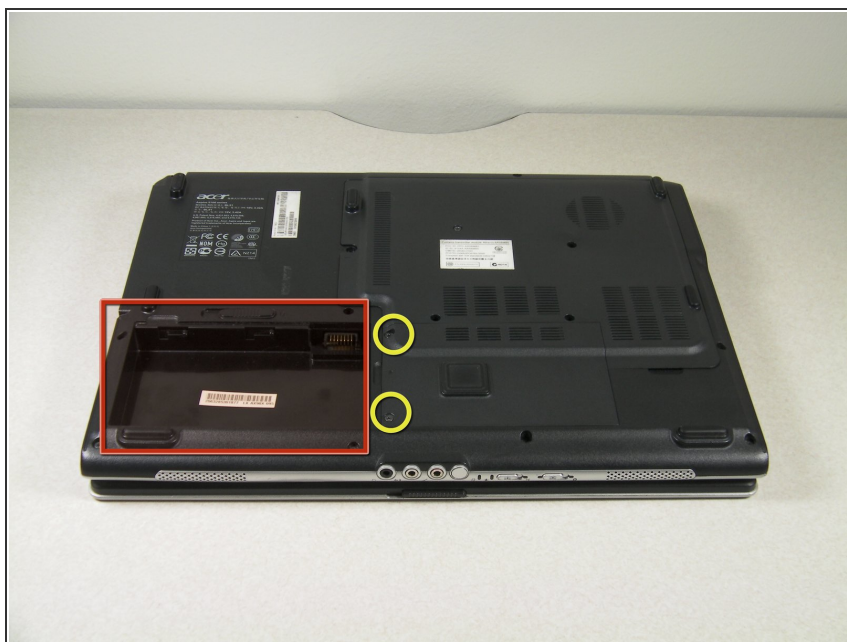

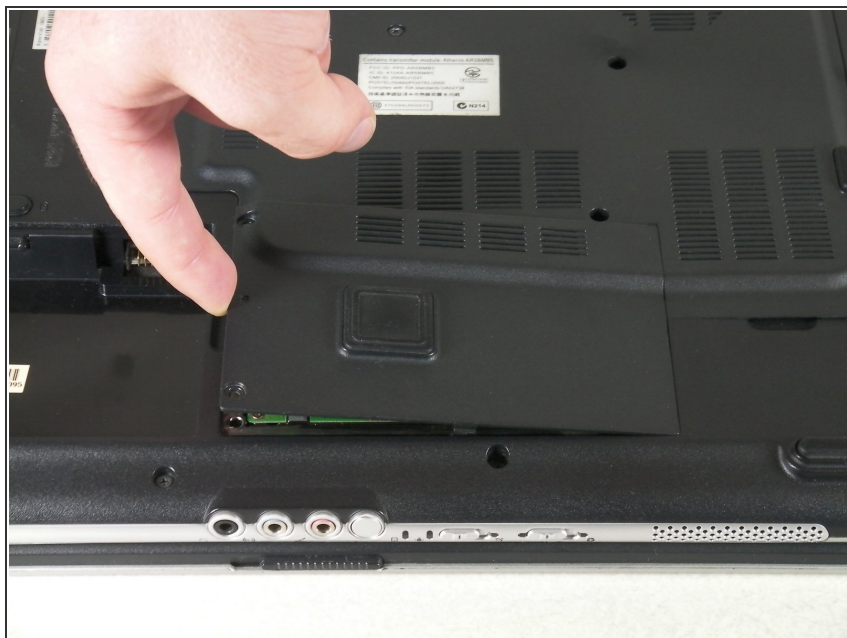

Step 1 — Hard Disk Drive



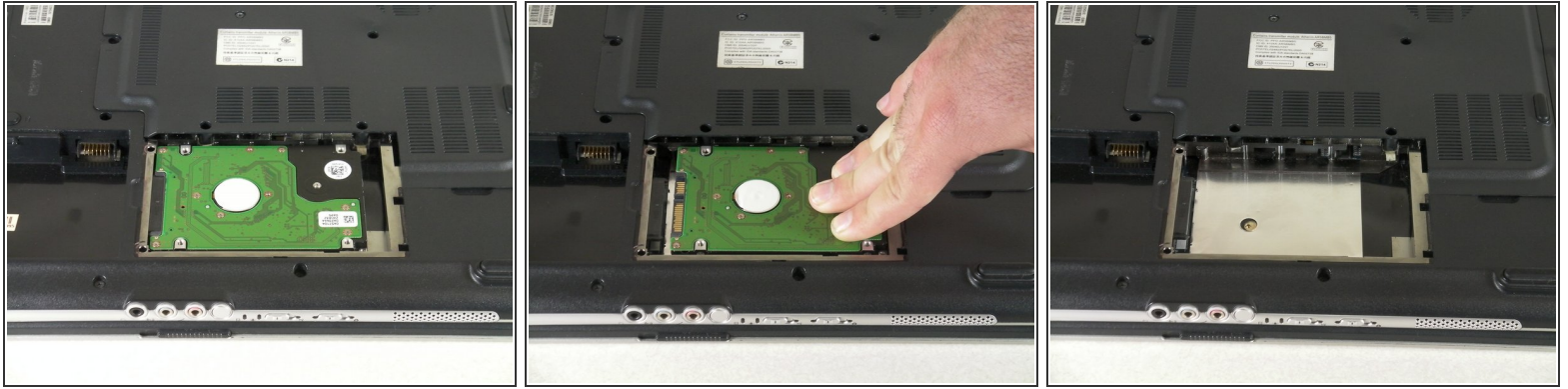
- Place laptop upside down.
- To get to the hard drive, remove the two screws located on the panel to the right of the battery.
- Although the battery is missing in this photo, it is not necessary to remove.

Step 2



- Lift up the panel.

Step 3



- Hard disk drive should now be visible.
- Slide the hard disk drive to the right to disconnect it from the laptop.
- Lift up and remove the hard disk drive.
- Slide in the new hard disk drive.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
