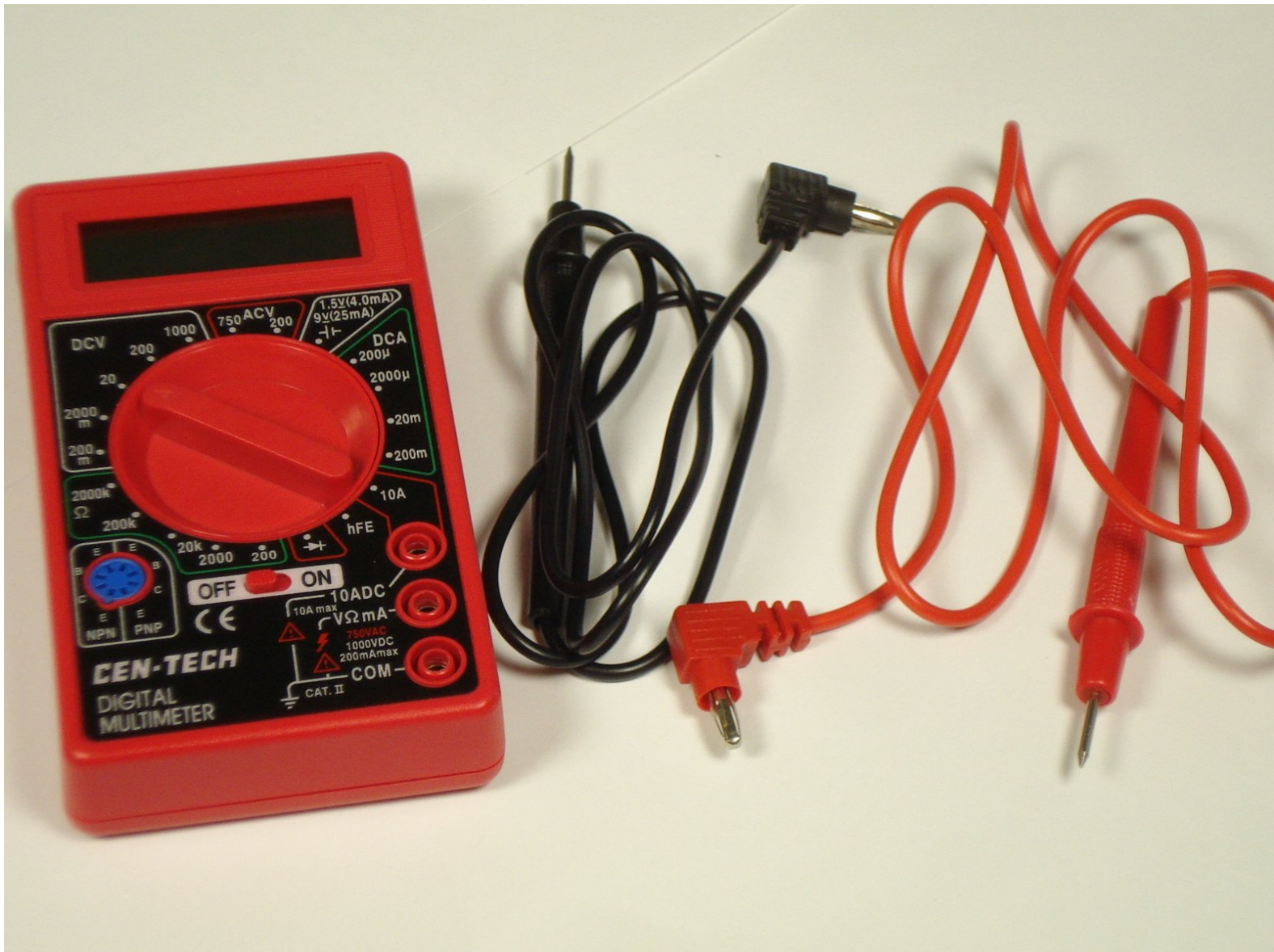




# How to check Sony Ericsson W200i battery voltage

Guide to remove and check for battery problems in the Sony Ericsson W200i.

## INTRODUCTION

Checking the battery is fairly easy, all you will need is a multimeter, which can be purchased at a local hardware store.

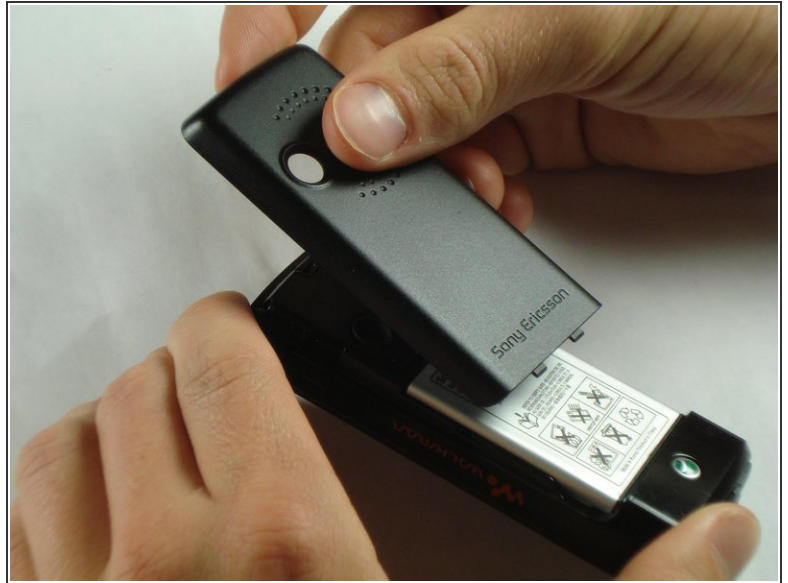

## Step 1 — Disassembling Sony Ericsson W200i Battery



- Slide the battery cover up and off the phone.

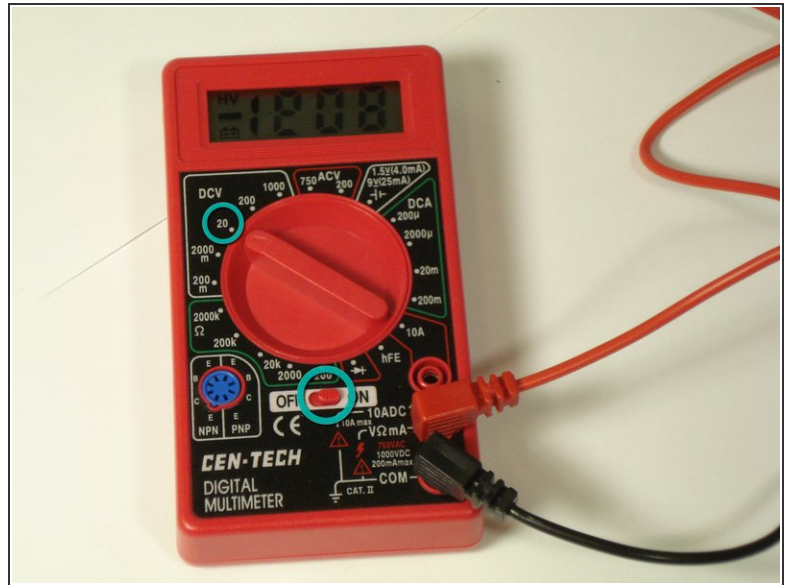
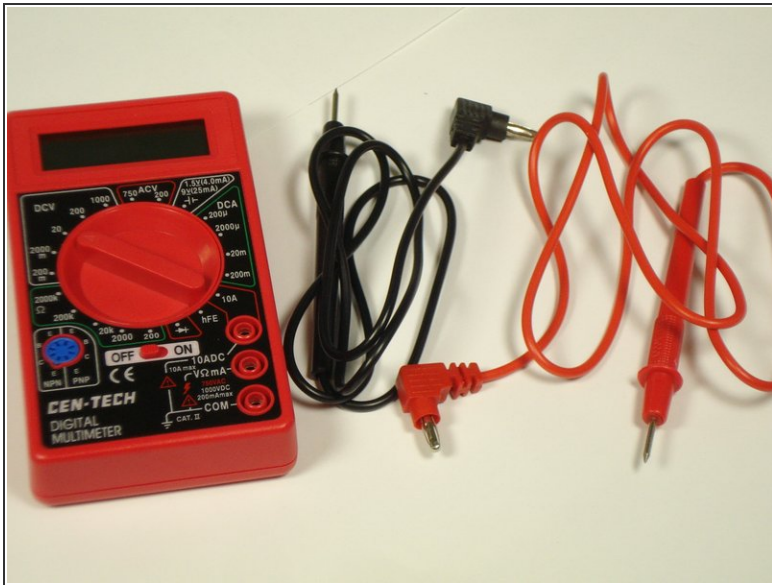
## Step 2



- Pop the battery out of its slot by lifting it up.

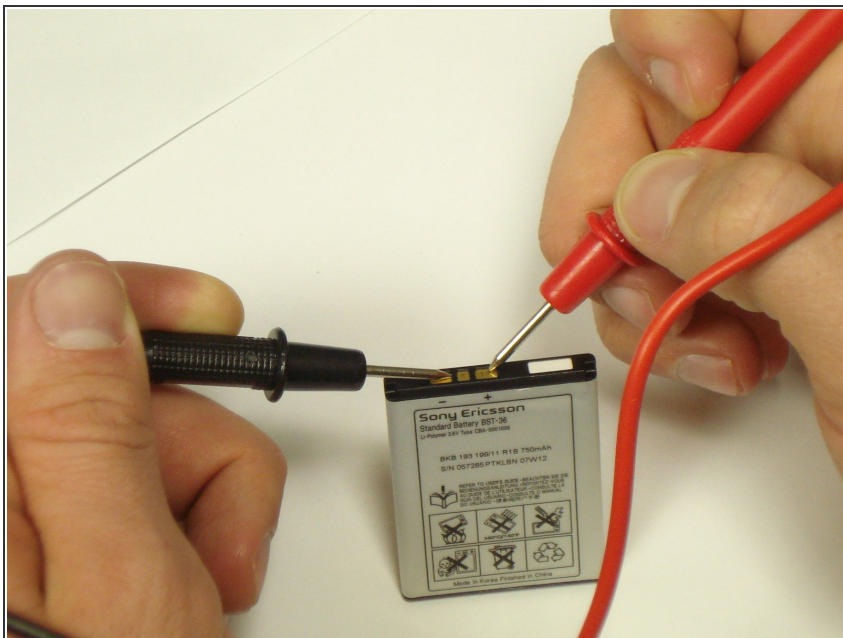


### Step 3 — How to check Sony Ericsson W200i battery voltage



- Plug the red probe into the center jack, the black probe into the bottom jack, and turn the range selector switch to 20 DCV.
- Turn the multimeter on.

### Step 4



- Touch the red probe to the indicated positive side and the black probe to the indicated negative side.
- Replace the battery if the voltage reads below 2.5 volts.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
