INTRODUCTION

In this guide you will be removing the side case doors. This is a necessary step to replace every other component on the HP Compaq dx2000MT.

TOOLS:

- [Anti-Static Wrist Strap](#) (1)
- [Flathead Screwdriver](#) (1)

Can be used instead of the Torx T15 and Phillips #2 screw drivers

- [Phillips #2 Screwdriver](#) (1)

Step 1 — Case Doors



- Turn off your computer and remove the power cable by pulling it straight out of its socket.

Step 2



- Remove the two Phillips #2 screws that secure the case door to the device.

Step 3



- Remove the side case door by pushing towards the rear of the device with your hand.
 - ⓘ This may take considerable force so keep pushing!
- Once you slide the door back, remove it by pulling it outwards from the device.

Step 4



- Remove the side case door by pushing towards the rear of the device with your hand.
 - ⓘ Once again, this may take considerable force.
- Once you slide the door back, remove it by pulling it outwards from the device.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
