Step 1 — Removing the Back Cover



- Power off your device before beginning the battery replacement (hold the button with the red marker until the device prompts you to power it off, then tap "Power Off").

⚠ Be wary of the front screen and SIM Card while tearing down the device.

Step 2



★ Put on an Anti-Static Wrist Strap to prevent damage to sensitive electrical components (optional).

- To separate the frame from the cover, pry between the screen and the cover using a plastic prying tool.

⚠ Begin at the top left of the device to avoid damaging the motherboard and work your way around the perimeter of the screen.

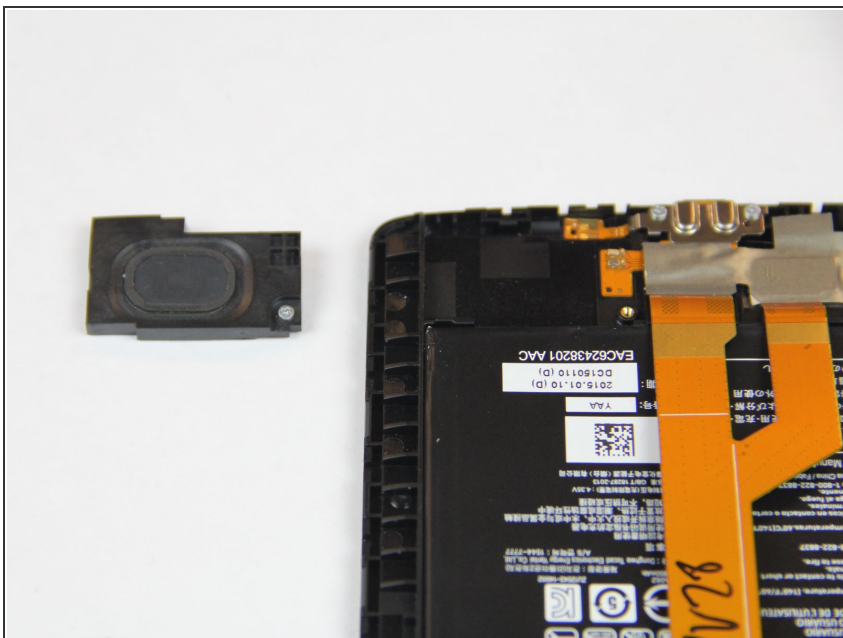
⚠ When you pry your device open, be wary of the volume rockers, motherboard, and camera. These components are delicate and can be sensitive to static electricity.

Step 3 — Speaker



- Remove (1) Silver 3mm PH0 screw from the speaker (red marker).

Step 4



- Remove speaker from device.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
