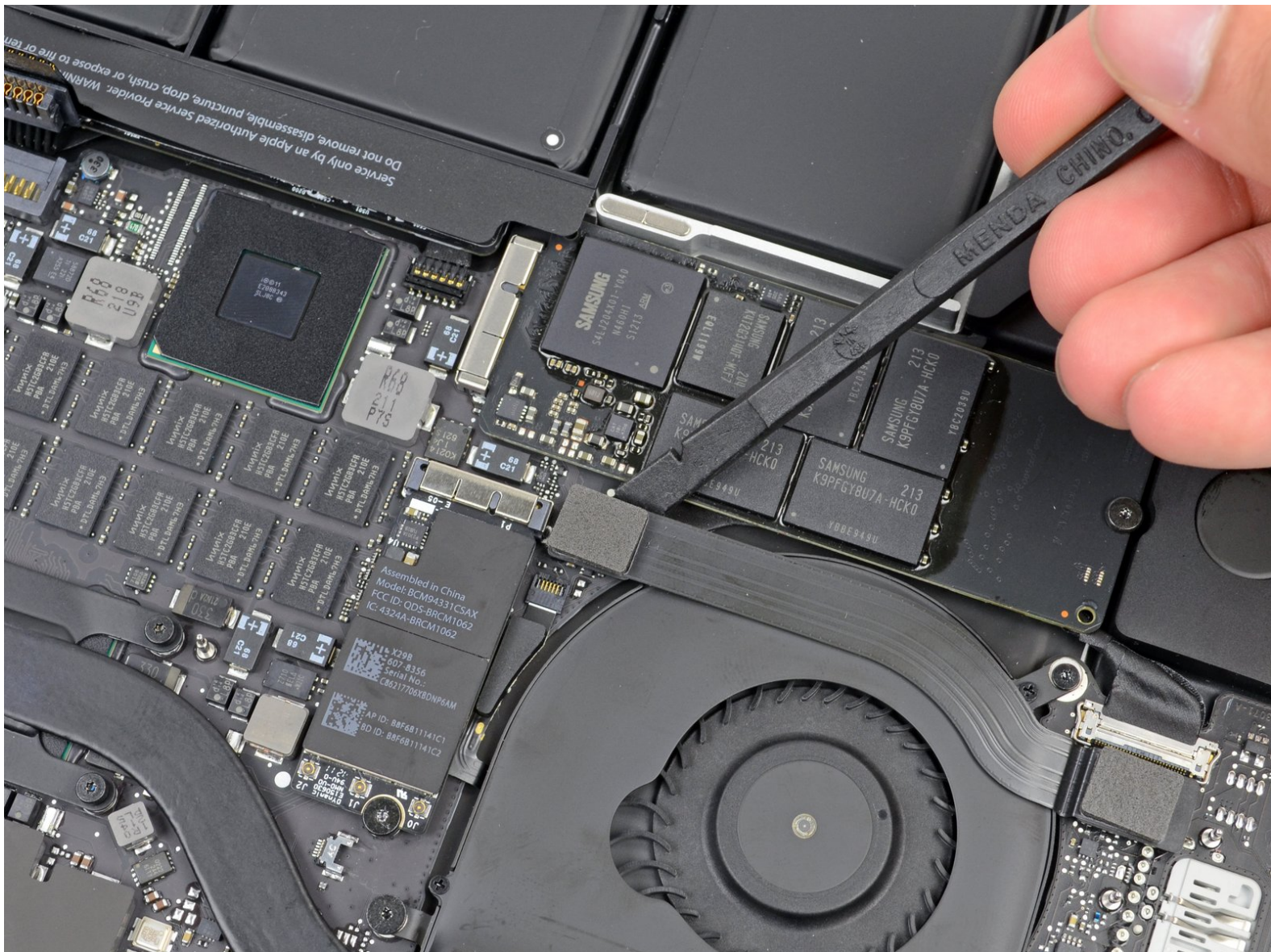




MacBook Pro 15" Retina Display Mid 2012 I/O Board Cable Replacement

Pre-req only

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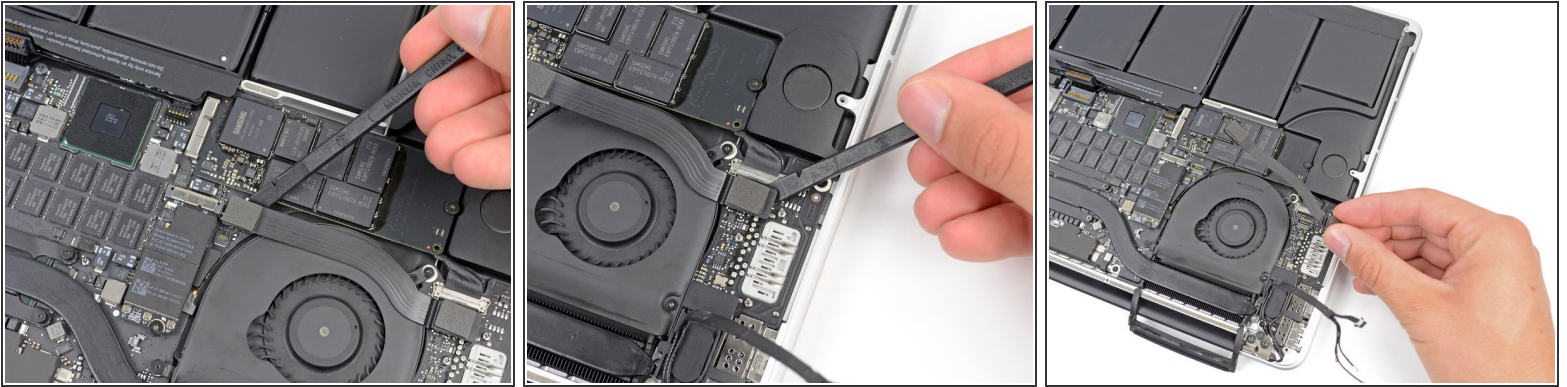
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TOOLS:

- Spudger (1)
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Step 1 — I/O Board Cable



- i** If your I/O Board cable's connectors have [notches in the padding](#), you will need to **release a locking lever underneath the notch** in order to remove the cable. If this is the case, **don't pry up on the connector until the levers are unlatched**.
- Using the flat end of a spudger, pry the I/O Board connector straight up out of its socket on the logic board.
 - During reassembly, connect this end first as it does not flex.
 - In a similar fashion, remove the I/O Board connector from its socket on the I/O Board.
 - Remove the I/O Board cable from the MacBook Pro.

To reassemble your device, follow these instructions in reverse order.
